

swer was sent to Texas, and put an end to all negotia- tion for annexation. The senator from South Carolina came into the Department of State, procured the reversal of the President's order, and gave the pledge to the whole extent that Texas asked it. Without, in the least, denying the knowledge of the armistice, and the negotiations for peace, and all the terrible consequences which were to result from their breach, he accepts the whole, and gives the fatal pledge which his predecessors had refused, and follows it up by sending our troops and ships to fight a people with whom we were at peace—the whole veil- ed by the mantle of secrecy, and protected by motives as unfounded as they were absurd. Now, what says morality and Christianity to this conduct? Certainly if two individuals were engaged in strife, and two others should part them, and put them under an agree- ment to submit to an amicable settlement; and while the settlement was going on, another man, lying be- hind a hedge, should secretly be making a whole party to break off the agreement and renew the strife, and promise to take the fight off his hands if he did: what would morality and Christianity say to this? Surely the malice of all good men would fall upon the man who had interfered to renew the strife. And if this was the voice of all good men in the case of mere individuals, what would be the voice of the strife was between nations, and when the renewal of it was to involve a third nation in the contest, and such a war as we now have with our sister republic of Mexico? This is the question which now presents itself to the moral sense of the civilized world, in judging the conduct of the senator from South Carolina writing that letter of the 14th of April, 1847, aggravated by now throwing upon another the blame of a war which he then contracted.

**Monroe County.**

Whereas, the time is approaching when it will be necessary to select some suitable person to bear the democratic banner in the approaching congressional campaign; and whereas a number of individuals have been presented before the public for that important office, and it is essentially and absolutely necessary to have harmony and concert of action in the democratic ranks: Therefore,

Resolved, That we consider it all important that the democracy of the 6th Congressional district should meet in convention on Wednesday the 14th day of April, 1847, at Bloomfield, by suitable delegates, appointed either by county or township meetings, as each county may deem most advisable.

Resolved, That in order that the convention, when constituted, should be in reality what it purports to be—a democratic convention—we would suggest to our democratic brethren of this district, that each county should be entitled to one vote for every hundred democratic voters in said counties composing the 6th congressional district.

Resolved, That we hereby pledge ourselves to adhere to the democratic nominee through "evil as well as good report," and to discountenance any candidate who will not submit his pretensions to, and abide by, the decision of his democratic brethren when assembled in convention.

Resolved, That in the approaching congressional campaign we believe that the whigs will not only have a regular nominee of their own in the field, but that they are now and will hereafter endeavor to divide and distract the democratic party to the utmost extent of their power, we would most earnestly call upon the democracy of this district to be "up and doing;" and we would further advise, not only that each county in the district should be fully represented in convention, but also that they should frequently hold county and township meetings to devise such measures as may best promote the triumph of democratic principles.

Resolved, That having full confidence in the tried democracy, integrity, and talents of Dr. William C. Foster, we recommend him to the convention as a pro- duce in every way qualified to discharge the duties of a Representative in Congress; and believing that one who faithfully served his country during the last war with England, will as faithfully serve his country and its people in the councils of the nation, we respectfully urge his claims upon the democracy of this district.

## Congress.

Feb. 27.—The Senate held a long session, in the course of which it passed several appropriation and other bills. A committee of conference was appointed on the naval appropriation bill. The bill for the relief of the people of Ireland and Scotland was passed by a vote of 27 to 13. It appropriates \$500,000 to be expended for provisions, to be sent to England in national vessels, under the direction of the President. Mr. Niles made an interesting speech of three hours' length upon the three million bill. An earnest appeal was made by Mr. Sevier to take the vote upon the bill to-night, in accordance with what appeared to be the general understanding some days back, but it was unsuccessful, and the bill was postponed until Monday, by a vote of 27 to 13. Mr. J. M. Clayton having the floor. Mr. Bright, on certain bonds of the State of Indiana, held by the United States; which was read and passed to the second reading.

The House, in committee of the whole on the state of the Union, had under consideration the bill, reported from the committee on ways and means, entitled "a bill to increase the revenue derivable from duties on imports, also from the sales of public lands, to aid in the prosecution of the war with Mexico." After the consideration of numerous amendments, a substitute form was reported to the House, and was agreed to, yeas 105, nays 103. The bill was subsequently taken on the passage of the vote, it was rejected, by yeas 78, nays 136. The bill for organizing and officering the new regiments was amended in the House so as to authorize 1st, the appointment of not more than two major generals and not more than three brigadiers; and 2d, to authorize the President to designate any major general of regulars or volunteers, actual or brevet, as commander in chief. The amendment was adopted by yeas 112, nays 86. The bill then passed, yeas 121, nays 75.

**Do not let it be forgotten that the Indiana State Journal fully endorses and approves of the anti-war speech of Senator Corwin, of Ohio. The editor was in so great a hurry to give this defence of Mexico to its readers, that it published its Monday's tri-weekly containing it, on Saturday evening, so that its pious patrons might have it to read on Sunday! Let it be remembered also, that the same Corwin who, himself defended Mexico, and condemns his own country, now votes, less than a year ago, to bring on this very war which he now so eloquently deprecates and denounces, because he desires to be talked about, and to be the next federal-abolition-whig candidate for the Presidency. There have been two editions of this speech; but whether the Journal publishes the authorized version, or not, we do not know. It does not much matter; for either of them are as reasonable in sentiment as ever Benedict Arnold was in practice.**

**FRANKIE ARDUS,** is the title of a new paper published at Jacksonville, Ill., by BARLOW & ABBOTT. The latter chap we know; and advise his partner to keep a good look out for him. **LARGE ESTATE.**—C. A. Mulken, son of an English peer, owns 30,000 acres of land in Wisconsin, which he purchased at a Government sale. Laws which permit such a monopoly of the soil as this, cannot be of the most hurtful tendency ultimately. Can Congress ever be compelled to pass laws limiting the sales of public lands to actual settlers? Every candidate for Congress ought to be questioned on this vital point.
