LATEST OLD WORLD NEWS

Intrigues of the German Emperor and Her Friends Begin to Bear Fruit.

Herr Von Puttkamer, Vice-President of the Ministerial Council, Tenders His Resignation—General News by Ocean Cable.

GERMAN INTRIGUES.

The Vice-President of the Prussian Ministerial Council Tenders His Resignation.

Berlin, June 8.—The North German Gazette, Prince Bismarck's organ, commenting upon the eventuality of a change of Ministry, says: "Such a change would not be of grave importance if it only resulted in showing the incapacity of the opposition. Symptoms of instability and disunion in the Ministry would be more serious. They would serve to depress the confidence of the friends of the Ministry, to encourage the hopes of their opponents, and to lead the latter to conclude that the ruling powers were no longer what they were, while the task of the Ministry would be especially difficult."

The Gazette does not believe in sacrifice of the Emperor's interest to personal feeling.

Herr Von Puttkamer, vice-president of the Prussian Ministerial Council and Prussian Minister of the Interior, has asked the Emperor for permission to resign. Herr Von Puttkamer's decision to resign, the dispatch says, is owing to the contents of an autograph letter from the Emperor which he received last evening.

The Post and National Zeitung state positively that Minister Von Puttkamer has resigned.

QUEEN VICTORIA'S NEW EMPIRE.

A Scheme to Absorb Africa as India Was Conquered and Absorbed.

London Letter in New York World.

Within the past few days Queen Victoria has, quietly and almost unobserved, succeeded in adding to her dominions a vast empire, almost continental in size and peopled by some seventy millions of industrious and relatively prosperous inhabitants. The immense tract which has just been constituted as British territory extends from Zanzibar northward as far as Abyssinia, with a seaboard of over seventeen hundred miles in length. Westward it reaches to beyond the Victoria Nyanza and the other great lakes from which the Nile takes its source, and includes the finest lands and richest markets of central Africa.

Mindful of the fact that England owes her Canadian dominion and her great Indian empire to the Hudson Bay Company and the defunct East India Company, respectively, Lord Salisbury's government has in the present instance proceeded with the same characteristic caution.

A royal charter based on the lines of that of the old East India Company has been granted to a powerful association promoted chiefly by Lady Burdett-Coutts, and constituted under the name of the East African Company. The latter is authorized to take possession of the district in question, to exercise justice, to collect revenue, to deal with refractory subjects "by force of arms," and, in fact, to wield all the power of a semi-independent government.

With laudable foresight the charter states that the extent of the territory westward of the great central African lakes "has not yet been ascertained." But as the chairman of the new East African Company is the millionaire Scotch merchant, Mackintosh, who is the principle shareholder in King Leopold's Congo empire and the financial backer of Stanley's "rescue expedition," it may be fairly taken for granted that within a short time the clutches of John Bull will reach across the continent.

Without discussing the incredible impudence of Lord Salisbury in thus granting to a London company a rich, prosperous and populated district which he has no vestige of a right in, it is most interesting to watch the absolutely cold-blooded manner in which John Bull proceeds to satisfy his voracious land-grabbing instincts. The district in question, to exercise justice, the Empire in 1837, when Queen Victoria ascended the throne, with those of to-day is extremely unproductive, and the question arises as to what measure England will be driven to adopt for the purpose of gratifying her greed when, in a very short time, every speck of land between the north and south poles will have been appropriated by one power or another.

GENERAL FOREIGN NEWS.

Austria Preparing to Expend Large Sums in Preparing for War.

Vienna, June 8.—The Neue Freie Presse says that the Austrian budget which will be submitted to the Delegation shows an increased expenditure of 5,000,000 florins, of which 4,500,000 florins have been absorbed in the budget. Thirteen millions of florins are asked for new repeating rifles and 4,000,000 for army organization. The extraordinary special credit of the War Department amounts to 47,250,000 florins, of which 16,000,000 florins have already been expended; the balance will be used for future requirements, and the balance reserved for emergencies.

England's Military Needs.

London, June 8.—The Daily Telegraph continues to print war scare articles. It advises the Hartington commission to appoint a minister of national defense to decide disputed military and naval questions, and to appoint a defense committee, consisting of military, naval and civilian members, to examine the heads of naval and military departments, and to report to Parliament. The Telegraph says that the need of five more iron-clads and 120 fast cruisers.

Foreign Notes.

The Italian Chamber of Deputies yesterday agreed to abolish capital punishment.

The English government has withdrawn the licensing clause of the county government bill.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, at the request of the archbishop of Canterbury, has consented to reconsider his resignation.

In Upper Egypt the cotton crop is forward and in excellent condition. In some of the delta provinces, however, it is backward, but healthy. The season is cold. Water is abundant.

The Khedive of Egypt has dismissed Nubar Pasha, president of the Council, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Minister of Justice, and has summoned Riaz Pasha to form a Cabinet.

The Italian Chamber of Deputies yesterday rejected the petition of Italian bishops asking the extradition of the penal code and imposing penalties upon the clergy for abuses committed in the exercise of their functions be eliminated.

Refugees In and Out of the Trust.

PHILADELPHIA, June 8.—Mr. Clara Spreckels, to-day, in the course of a conversation regarding the sugar industry, when asked to give some information about the refineries in and out of the trust, said: "There are twenty refineries in the sugar trust. They have already been enumerated. As to those out of the trust, and their capacity, I can tell you something which will interest your readers. There is the California sugar refinery, of San Francisco, with daily capacity of 1,200,000 pounds; then, there is Harrison & Frazier with about 1,500,000; U. C. Knight & Co., are said to produce 400,000 pounds a day; the new refinery here will produce 2,000,000 pounds a day, making 5,000,000 pounds or 2,500 tons a day produced by refineries out of the trust. The consumption of sugar in the United States is 1,200,000 tons a year. The refineries out of the trust, including the new refinery, will produce the capacity of five million pounds, or 2,500 tons a year. This leaves only 670,000 tons a year for the refineries of the trust, or much less than one-half. You see, therefore, that the four refineries out of the trust, have a greater capacity than twenty in the trust, and have nothing to fear from them."

Depriving New Orleans of Revenue.

NEW ORLEANS, June 8.—On Tuesday last Mayor Shakespeare ordered fifty copies of the license inspection books to be turned over to the police, with instructions that the force be required to report at once the names of all persons who have failed to pay or have underpaid their licenses. To-day Chief Hennessy sent to the police the result of the first day's work, showing that 663 persons and firms are doing

business without having paid the license required by law. The list embraces bankers, brokers, lawyers, commission merchants, physicians, short-keepers, etc. The city has not money enough to pay the current expenses of the government.

TELEGRAPHIC BREVITIES.

McGarrigle, the Chicago woodier, is rusticated at Banff Hot Springs, N. W. T., spending money freely.

At Bradford, Pa., last night, Patrick Hanlon was stabbed in the abdomen by John Canfield. The affray was the result of a quarrel over a trunk which Hanlon claimed.

Lightning struck the house of Julius Becker, a prosperous German farmer, residing near Denon, followed by a fire which resulted in killing his daughter and seriously injuring both him and his wife. The latter may not recover.

In Bloomington, Chamix county, Dakota, Thursday night, two young farmers, named Bailey and Wilson, quarreled over an old grudge. Bailey fired at Wilson but killed his own father. Wilson, in turn, shot Bailey dead.

Five men were horribly burned by the overturning of a ladle at the Bessemer mill of the Pennsylvania Steel company, at Hochelaga, yesterday. Wilson Snuffer died in an hour and Samuel Zartors cannot live. The others are seriously burned.

In the Supreme Court of Michigan, yesterday, in a case brought up to test the constitutionality of that section of the liquor law of 1887 which prevents liquor-dealers, brewers, etc., from going on the bonds of retail liquor dealers, the court decided that portion was constitutional.

The boiler of an engine on the farm of Edwin Mickle, at Maple Grove, Lehigh county, Pennsylvania, exploded yesterday and was immediately followed by the explosion of a quantity of dynamite and a quantity of powder, which was stored in the engine-house. Mr. Mickle's barn, erected at a cost of \$5,000, was completely wrecked. A window pane a half mile distant was broken.

Losses by Fire.

APLETON, Wis., June 8.—The Atlas paper-mill, owned by a stock company controlled by the Kimberly-Clark Company, was destroyed by fire this morning. The fire is supposed to have started in the vicinity of the boiler. Loss, \$150,000; insurance from \$50,000 to \$60,000, in mutual companies. A fireman was almost asphyxiated in the burning building.

WELLSVILLE, O., June 8.—At 2 o'clock this morning fire broke out in Branton's livery stable, followed by the burning of the contents of stores and contents of J. B. Smith, Reed Millin, two livery stables, together with several horses and a number of carriages. Snowden's fire and insurance company, of Cincinnati, was the insurer. Loss, \$15,000.

MONTREAL, June 8.—Fire broke out at 1 o'clock this morning in the stables of the Montreal Hotel, on the corner of St. Heloise and St. Jacques, before help could reach the horses in the larger stable the entire building was a mass of flames. All efforts to save the imprisoned animals were fruitless, only one out of 135 being rescued. The shrieks of the frightened animals and their cries of pain were heard blocks away. Several of them managed to burst through the wooden walls of the stable, where they were found that had fallen upon them from the left above the stalls. The moment they regained the open air they turned, and, in their panic, dashed into the street, where they were trampled by the stables which stood there. The gasometer that recently exploded and killed six men in the rear of the large stable was a small child in the crowd, which was trampled by these were badly burned, and several firemen were killed. The fire was not extinguished until 4 o'clock. The loss will reach \$100,000.

Starting Accident at Niagara.

LOCKPORT, N.
