

CRITICISED BY A SOCIALIST

Caprivi and Germany's Emperor Assailed in the Reichstag by Herr Bebel.

Army and Navy Bankrupting Prussia—Journalists Not the Only Propagators of Unrest—Royal Orators Doing Likewise.

[Copyright, 1891, by the New York Associated Press.] BERLIN, Nov. 28.—The debate in the Reichstag on the budget to-day was unwontedly lively. After Herr Buhl, National Liberal, had spoken in defense of the policy pursued by Prince Bismarck during his tenure of office as Chancellor of the empire, and had commented adversely upon the course adopted by Chancellor Von Caprivi, Herr Bebel, Socialist leader, criticised the rapid increase of the imperial debt and of the army and navy appropriations. He contended that it was inevitable in the event of war that a number of the German states should become bankrupt. How, he asked, could such immense masses of troops be long moved and fed? Expressions had recently been used which conveyed to these masses of soldiers the idea that they might be employed not only against a foreign foe, but also against an enemy within the empire.

Agitated murmurs from every part of the house followed this allusion to the recent utterance of the Emperor, Herr Bebel, continuing, said that every thousand new recruits social democracy was being more and more strongly infused into the army. As Chancellor Von Caprivi had pictured journalists as the only propagators of unrest, he felt bound to say that many orators were also engaged in the work of agitation, an idea, as an instance, the speech recently delivered at Erfurt by a high personage.

At this point the Vice-president of the Reichstag, Count Bismarck, interrupted the speaker, refusing to allow the Emperor's speech to be subjected to criticism. Herr Bebel said he would leave his comparison in the hands of the Emperor, but that it was not journalism that spread a feeling of unrest throughout the country. Touching the protectionist policy, he said the very tariff imposed by the government coupled with the military expenditures, had created enormous economic difficulties. The slight reduction in corn duties in the treaty of commerce with Austria would not suffice to offset the want of proper nourishment from which millions suffered, the result being an enormous increase of disease, mortality and crime. The structure of the middle class of society, Herr Bebel continued, was built in a swamp, in which it was rotting and probably to rot still further for another and better social organization. The country had got rid of one enemy of social reform when Prince Bismarck was driven from power.

Herr Count Bismarck again called Herr Bebel to order, declaring that the expression used in connection with the ex-Chancellor's name could not be permitted being directed against an absent member of the house. Herr Bebel replied that Prince Bismarck has not yet taken his seat in the house and proceeded with his denunciation of the government, which, he asserted, was following, as far as it dared, in Prince Bismarck's footsteps, while assuming the role of protector of the working classes. Chancellor Von Caprivi, he said, believed the country appreciated the efforts made by the government for the amelioration of the lot of the working classes. The Chancellor proceeded to refer to the Guelf fund bill shortly to be introduced in the Landtag, maintaining the confiscation of the fund and the leaving of the interest arising therefrom free of control by Parliament. According to the provisions of the bill an account of the fund would be audited and the report is to be communicated to the Landtag.

RUSSIAN LOAN.

The assurance of peace given by M. De Giers, the Russian Foreign Minister, during his stay in this city, had a close connection with the negotiations of the Russian government with Berlin financiers. Despite the recent declarations of the government against German capital propping up Russian finances, several big firms here and at Frankfurt sent agents to hold a secret conference with the Russian Minister of Finance, when he passed through Frankfurt on his way to Paris. The reports that financiers were consulting with the Russian Minister of Finance have caused a revival of the attacks by the press upon Russian finance. These attacks are partly inspired by the government, whose position in the matter is unchanged.

It is announced that the Emperor will preside over the formation of a commission for the purpose of investigating the affairs of Herr Miguel, Imperial Minister of Finance to preside over the deliberations of the commission, but the Finance Minister declined to act.

Mr. Koch, president of Reichsbank, is selected in his stead. The ultra-conservatives are endeavoring to make a Bourne reform coupled with the Jewish question, a plank in their party platform. At a mass-meeting held here under the auspices of the anti-Semitic League, at which the Emperor and the Finance Minister were invited, several persons were present, the proposal to place restrictions upon the operations of Jewish financiers in finance, on the Bourse and in commerce, were vigorously applauded.

The conflict between the four great American life insurance companies—the Mutual New York Life, the American and Equitable and the Finance Ministry over the law obliging these companies to invest the premiums received in three-and-a-half-per-cent bonds, continues. Some of these companies receive nearly 5,000,000 marks yearly in German premiums, and this money they invest at 5 per cent. Hon. William von Bismarck, the American minister to Germany, has successfully interceded with Herr Miguel, the Imperial Finance Minister, on behalf of the companies, and has secured a reduction of the government's demands, with a prospect of obtaining a repeal of the law. Mr. Phelps has called the attention of the Minister to the fact that German life insurance companies, which operate largely in the United States, are permitted to do business on depositing guarantee moneys. The American life insurance companies doing business in Germany are willing to accept a similar arrangement.

Minister Phelps on Thanksgiving day attended three receptions of the day. In a speech delivered at a banquet, Mr. Phelps appeared to anticipate a reduction of the corn tariff. He said: "The American has entered the Brandenburg gate, but it is still hungry. By Christmas, however, it will have all it wants—cheap and enough." American corn promises to assume an important place in the manufacture of soap in Germany. Hitherto the manufacturers have used linseed oil, procured in Russia, but owing to the failure of the crop there they were compelled to look in other directions for a supply of oil. East Indian linseed oil was tried, but the experiment was unsuccessful. An eminent chemist, after many experiments, decided that the oil obtained from corn was best suited for uses of the manufacturers. The latter are now obtaining their supplies from Chicago, and the chances are that the trade now will equal \$200,000 or \$300,000 yearly.

Mr. D. C. Bell, agent of the United States Treasury, is of the opinion that the industry, once started, will assume immense proportions. A dispatch from Rio de Janeiro received to-day states that the German minister to Brazil on Thursday had a conference with the Brazilian Minister of Foreign Affairs regarding the negotiations of a commercial treaty between the two countries. The conference, the dispatch adds, resulted favorably.

On Tuesday of next week the King of Denmark, incognito, will visit the Emperor at Potsdam.

Found Dead in a Corn-Field. BLOOMINGTON, Ill., Nov. 28.—Two men, while hunting in a corn-field belonging to Job Ross, about a mile and a half east of this city, this morning, found the dead body of an unknown man. He was well dressed, but there was nothing to indicate the cause of death. His appearance had been dead several days.

Politicians Barred Out. CORSICANA, Tex., Nov. 28.—The anti-subversive members of the Farmers' Alliance, in convention here, have organized the order under the original charter. The new

constitution provides for prohibiting any man from becoming a member who belongs or aids in any way secret class organization that makes political demands upon its members, or in any way exercises any of the distinctive functions of a political party. The ritual prohibits any man from becoming a member who favors socialism, communism or anarchism. B. J. Kendrick, of Waco, was elected president; J. S. Gilbert, of Caddo, vice-president; W. G. Gass, of Dallas, secretary and treasurer. The movement, it is claimed, will absorb the sub-treasury organization.

UNIVERSITY EXTENSION.

Western College Professors Discuss the Subject and Organize for Carrying Out Their Plans.

CHICAGO, Nov. 28.—A notable conference of Western educators was held at the Newberry Library to-day. The matter under discussion was university extension, or bringing a broad and special education to persons who cannot attend universities. There were present President Harper, of the University of Chicago; President Rogers, of the Northwestern University; President Chamberlain, of Madison University; President Eaton, of Beloit University; President Coulter, of the University of Indiana; Regent Barrill, of the University of Illinois; Professors Moss and Forbes, of the University of Michigan; Professors Turner and Freeman, of Madison University; Professor Young, of the Northwestern University, and Dr. Poole, of the Newberry Library. The conference, after a long discussion, resolved itself into a board of college professors, to consist of a president and two professors of each college. The duties of this board will be to choose lecturers for the various courses and to decide on a system of credits for work performed. There was also appointed an executive board composed of President Rogers, of the Northwestern University; Professor L. C. Forest, and C. O. Roberts, of Lake Forest, and C. O. Roberts, of Indiana. This board will attend to the active work of directing the extension plans. While working in harmony, each college is to be allowed to carry on the work according to its own methods.

MEETING OF BIG GUYS.

Jay Gould and Other Magnates to Consider the Free-Pass Nuisance.

The indications are that there will be a notable gathering of railroad men in Chicago next Tuesday. The movement to restrict the issuing of free transportation has been taken up by the highest officers of the roads, instead of leaving the settlement question to their passenger agents. They have decided to come together themselves and endeavor to adopt an agreement that will practically abolish the pass system. A call for the meeting has been issued. It is signed by Presidents Marvin Huggitt, of the Chicago & Northwestern; Roswell Miller, of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul; Vice-president J. C. McMullin, of the Chicago & Alton; George B. Harris, of the Burlington, and William, of the Illinois Central. The call has been sent under cover to the presidents and managing officers of all the large railroad companies in the United States, several of whom have already signified their intention of being present. There is reason to believe that Jay Gould, Chauncey M. Depew, Collis P. Huntington, George B. Roberts, M. E. Ingalls and many others of similar rank will respond to the call. Although the Western roads took the lead in this matter, the Eastern lines have joined heartily in the movement. The meeting is to be under the auspices of the Western Traffic Association, and the object is to limit the issuance of passes to such an extent that they can only be given in exchange for advertising, or services actually rendered. As railroad officers would be unanimously of the opinion that the pass system has become a great nuisance, there is little doubt that the meeting will be a harmonious one, and that it will result in an iron-clad agreement.

Half-Fare World's Fair Rates.

The proposition that half rates be charged on all foreign exhibits to the world's fair, both coming and going, has been submitted to a vote of the members of the Western Traffic Association. Only a few of the votes are in its favor, and it is impossible to tell what the result will be. Among the railroad officers the principal advocates of half rates in both directions is E. P. Rinkley, vice-president of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul road, who argues that the railroads should be willing to do their part toward making the exposition a success. He contends, however, that the object is to limit the issuance of passes to such an extent that they can only be given in exchange for advertising, or services actually rendered. Emigrant Ticket Commission.

It remains to be seen whether the transcontinental lines will obey the order of Chairman Walker, of the Western Traffic Association, limiting commissions on emigrant tickets to 25 from Chicago and 25 from the Missouri river to California. Some of them make no attempt to conceal their dissatisfaction, and declare that if the order is obeyed it will shut them out of Castle Garden entirely, and give all the business to lines outside of the association. The order must be avoided, and the existing of their Eastern connections will enter into some arrangement to divide the business so that they can get a share of it. Miscellaneous Railway Notes.

W. C. Rineason, general passenger agent of the Erie road, has resigned. It is thought that he will become general traffic agent of the East Tennessee, Virginia & Georgia railroad. D. I. Roberts, assistant general passenger agent, is spoken of as his successor.

At Philadelphia yesterday, Frank W. Floy, vice agent of the Philadelphia & Reading railroad, appeared before United States Commissioner Craig and entered bail in the sum of \$1,000 for a hearing to-morrow to show the charge of violating the interstate-commerce laws by allowing a rebate of 7 cents per one hundred pounds on car brakes shipped from East St. Louis, Ill., to Philadelphia.

A train of ten cars, laden with 5,000 rolls of carpet, left the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western railroad station in Hoboken, N. J., yesterday. The train is scheduled to make the trip in ten days, which is about half the usual time. The train was sent out by the Great Eastern freight line, over the Lackawanna to Chicago, and the Santa Fe and Colorado Midland from there to the Golden Gate.

Wilder's Brigade at Chickamauga.

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn., Nov. 28.—General Wilder's brigade of mounted infantry, famous in the Army of the Cumberland, will be one of the first to mark its position on the battle-field at Chickamauga. The park commissioners have granted permission to the brigade to place its monument on the site of the widow Glenn's house, the advance position gained by Wilder after Sheridan was driven from his position on the right wing of the federal forces. A suitable tablet will be erected. The executive committee of the brigade is now asking for designs in marble, granite and bronze. The selection will be made and the monument erected so that it can be unveiled and dedicated on the next anniversary of the battle, when the Society of the Army of the Cumberland will meet here.


Gold from Australia.




