

SECRETS OF THE POISONER

Colorless, Tasteless Liquid with Which Roman Wives Slew Their Spouses.

The poisoner's art has been brought to the aid of the progress of science by constant improvements of its own. Only a few weeks ago one of the experts consulted in the trial of the New York student accused of causing the death of his wife quoted the opinion of several eminent specialists to the effect that "no chemical analysis can pretend to trace the vestiges of certain poisons as modified by the subsequent administration of other drugs."

In other words, poisoners have learned to cover the traces of their crime by taking the precaution to use more than one drug. Their presence, even if the stomach of the victim should have retained only the hundredth part of a grain, but the tests of the analysis are so delicate and so far from being unequivocal that their reliability depends upon conditions which are often made to modify.

The poisoners of antiquity had, indeed, to contend with a far more serious difficulty, viz., the circumstance that the injuriousness of many of their substances became manifest only when they were taken in large quantities, and that in some of their powdered forms an invisible trace can be tasted in the air on shaking a small quantity from one paper into another.

DEADLY AQUA TOFANA. About three hundred years ago the latter difficulty was obviated by the discovery of an Italian chemist, who found by experiments that long-continued boiling will communicate the properties of arsenic to soft water.
