SUNK IN THE QUICKSAND.

Schooner and Six of Her Crew Disappear—A Case Probably Without a Parallel.

The second mate, boatwain and four seamen left the vessel Thursday afternoon and were taken aboard an American schooner. Friday morning no trace of the bark could be seen, and the vessel was presumed to have sunk. The vessel was carrying a cargo of lumber, and the loss is estimated at \$100,000.
