RIGHT TO THE POINT Mayor Denny Gives a Straight Talk to Agitator Cummings. Visit of the Unemployed to the Board of Works—Men at Work Cleaning the Streets.

The unemployed, or that portion which has been in meetings in the Criminal Court room each week for the past few months, were again in the basement of the courthouse yesterday under the leadership of Cummings. A committee from the unemployed had reported that contractors at work constructing sewers were employing foreign labor in the work.

During the explanations being made by the contractors some of the men became bitter in their denunciation of the contractors. One man shook his fist at Derhelmer and said, "If you don't take the outsiders off your work, we will come down and take them off."

There has been more or less talk of this for years, but the city cannot acquire the plant till it is rid of the Belt railroad.

The committee on buildings and grounds recommended that the proposition of J. S. Cruse for property on Lexington avenue and the streets between Franklin and Madison streets be accepted at \$7,750.
