

SPECIE EXPORT TALK

Resort of the Bears to Further Reduce Prices on 'Change.

Several Declines the Result of a Dull Day in Wall Street—Indianapolis Grain Unchanged.

At New York yesterday money on call was easy at 1 per cent.

Prime mercantile paper, 3/8% per cent. Sterling exchange was steady, with actual business in bankers' bills at \$183.50 for 60 days; for demand and \$187.50 for 30 days; posted rates, \$188.50 for 60 days; commercial bills, \$188.50 for 60 days.

Silver certificates, 61/2c. Bar silver closed at 82 1/2c per ounce at London, 23 1/2c.

Total sales of stocks were 14,521. The share speculation was rather dull and the movement of prices was unimportant.

It was almost entirely a local traders' market, neither London nor the big home operators buying to any great extent.

The Arbitrage house, however, bought Atchison and Denver & Rio Grande preferred in small lots.

The general tendency of the foreign exchange market towards hardening had a depressing influence on the market, inasmuch as it revived gold export talk.

Exchange is not up to the shipping point, but it is regarded as not unlikely that the rates may advance to-day or Friday so as to render the exportation of gold profitable.

At the opening prices were generally higher than at the close Monday, but soon took downward turn.

Following in succession during the morning, the result being a depreciation in values.

Foreign exchange market assumed a firm tone and a steady advance took place, but of small proportions, which was in progress until shortly before 1:45, when came a selling movement, in which the earlier movement was lost and a lower range was established.

In the final dealings purchases to cover short contracts caused a fractional rally, and the market closed at a higher level than Monday, declining from 1/4 to 1/2, the latter in Delaware and Hudson.

The stock recovered 1/2. General Electric sold down 1/4 per cent. on Boston orders, closing 1/2 from 1/4. Bullion and gold movement in Chicago.

Government bonds were firm. State bonds were inactive.

LOCAL GRAIN AND PRODUCE.

Trade Slow Under Unfavorable Weather Conditions—Prices Steady.

The cold rain of the last forty-eight hours has had an unfavorable effect on trade generally, even wholesale grocers feeding it.

At dry goods, millinery and fancy goods houses but little is doing.

On Commission row the depression is not so marked. Eggs and poultry are both firmer.

Eastern demand having improved somewhat. Oranges are becoming scarce, and higher prices rule.

Lemons are plenty and, on light demand, selling low. Everything in the vegetable line carries a firmer tone.

Irish potatoes are in active demand, and the receipts falling off. Within the last thirty days 37,300 bushels of potatoes have been handled in this market.

The local grain market shows a little more activity than the last week.

'Change is more spirited. Track bids, however, keep along much in the same range.

An advance of one day has not the next day there is more doing than for some time past.

WHEAT RULED WEAK.

Heavy Chicago Stocks and Big Visible Caused a Decline.

Premium Between Cash and Futures Entirely Too Narrow to Suit the Bulls—Provisions Firm.

CHICAGO, April 10.—Wheat was weaker and closed with a loss of 7/8c to-day. The anticipated bearishness of the government report and favorable weather caused the decline.

Corn and oats were firm. Provisions were practically firm, but closed lower than yesterday.

Wheat opened weak at about the point it left off yesterday. The weather over the greater part of the winter wheat area was such as to warrant the expectation of its repairing the greater part of the damage done by the frost.

The twenty-million bushels of improvable wheat in Chicago began to loom up big again, and the unhealthy premium with which that wheat here was being traded in as compared with prices quoted at the principal winter wheat markets, caused comment on that condition of affairs to become more general.

Between opening and noon there was a heaviness which gradually disappeared as the day advanced.

At the start, after a slight advance there were sellers at 62 1/2c at the end.

The feeling of strength which corn displayed yesterday was again uppermost.

The market, after a good opening, became rather heavy around yesterday's closing values.

There was a fairly active business in oats to-day, started 4 1/2c higher than yesterday's close, sold at 32 1/2c and a 3/4c.

Just before the close there was a spike, and the market closed with buyers at 32 1/2c.

The provision market was strong and higher at the start, but the edge was taken off by free offerings of packers.

After some advance in the market, the market closed with buyers at 32 1/2c.
