for the insurgents and would send them  
armed relief. He said: "The concurrent  
resolution will be sent to the president  
of both houses of Congress and beyond that  
I will only say that you will find the president  
right, as usual. A recognition of the  
Cuban belligerent rights would mean that  
the insurgents would have precisely the  
same rights as Spain. Our people could en-  
list and would be treated as prisoners of  
war. The insurgents could then buy ma-  
terial of us the same as Spain can now  
and even munitions of war. They could not  
run their ships to our ports, but could  
buy all sorts of equipment."

Mr. Dickinson recalled history: "Every one  
understands now, I think, that in the  
case of our war with Spain, the belligerent  
rights of the Confederate State before the  
battle of Bull Run took place. Immediately  
after that recognition of the Southern  
belligerent rights was declared, Spain  
issued an order to her captain governing  
Cuba to open the ports of Cuba to ships  
bearing the Confederate flag and to grant  
the privileges of the most favored nation.  
Under that order, Confederate privateers  
captured our merchant ships and carried  
them into Cuban ports, where the privateers  
and their prizes were protected by Spain.  
Nine-tenths of the prizes captured by the  
Confederate cruisers and privateers were  
then protected in Cuban ports."

"It is generally assumed that in the ten  
years from 1868 to 1878—the last ten years  
of the Cuban war of independence—that  
the Cubans were finally conquered by  
Spain. This is not true. The present cap-  
tivity of the Cubans is the result of a  
greater part of that war, and the effort  
to subdue the insurgents was as complete  
a failure at the end of the war as it was  
at the beginning. It was in the year  
of that war as it has been at the close of  
the first year of this war. Spain in the  
third year ordered the capture of General  
Weyler, and sent over Captain General  
Canalejas, who declared a truce and invited  
a conference. The conference resulted in  
the negotiation of a treaty of peace—such a  
treaty of peace as was never negotiated be-  
tween nations."

"Campos contracted, in the name of Spain,  
to give Cuba autonomy by Spanish officials,  
home rule, leaving Spain in the relative  
position toward Cuba that England now  
occupies to the Transvaal, which is  
dealing only with foreign nations. Cuba  
then trusted Spain, and the insurgents laid  
down their arms. The Cubans were dis-  
armed and Spain once more in control of the island.  
Spain resoundingly repudiated the treaty,  
and from that time until the breaking  
out of the present rebellion Cuba sent  
delegations to Madrid, and especially ap-  
pealing for those things which she had  
won and which Spain had stolen, and ap-  
pealed in vain."

"The Cuban news we see in the press is  
edited by Spain, but every friend of Cuba  
in the United States, and especially in  
Washington, has authentic news, sent by  
messengers from Cuba, which is not  
thought best to publish for obvious  
reasons. The bulletins edited into the daily  
press of the United States by Spanish  
officials, announcing great Spanish victories,  
and so on, are false. The Cubans, so far  
from having been beaten, have won 95 per  
cent of every engagement."

Mr. Dickinson was asked: "Do you think  
that the feeling of sympathy among our  
citizens that they will organize and send  
expeditions of relief to Cuba?"

"I think it is wrong," said Mr. Dickinson,  
"only it will not do to let it be  
known prior to the recognition of the  
Cuban belligerent rights, for that our  
own government would interfere."

**ENGLISH EDITORS DO NOT APPROVE**

**SENATE'S ACTION**

LONDON, Feb. 28.—The action of the  
United States Senate yesterday on the  
Cuban question has aroused comment in  
the press of this city. An editorial in the  
Standard says: "The Senate has placed  
President Cleveland in a highly embarrassing  
position. It is a position which the proud  
Spanish nation would yield if America  
threatened war on behalf of Cuba. It is  
much to be hoped that President Cleveland  
will act prudently."

An editorial in the Times on the same  
subject says: "The resolution is very em-  
barrassing for Spain, who, while she could  
not regard the recognition as an unfriendly  
act, is in no position to resent it. She could  
gain nothing by declaring war against the  
United States, who, in addition, can make  
out a case, which is at least plausible, that  
it is merely a tardy and reluctant recogni-  
tion of palpable facts. The supplementary  
resolution was accordingly adopted in deference  
to those who would gladly provide a wa-  
termark for the United States, and who prob-  
ably will, with a directness of speech in  
which American politicians often indulge,  
could not fall to prove in the highest de-  
gree offensive to a proud and sensitive peo-  
ple, whatever course the President may  
decide to take on this resolution and the  
inflammatory language in which it was  
discussed, demand the most serious con-  
sideration. The resolution is a matter of  
such difficulty and delicacy that she may  
well command the sympathy even of  
those disapproving the recent history of  
Cuba. Distasteful as almost any course,  
save an obstinate continuance of the struggle,  
must be to the majority of Spaniards, it  
may perhaps be advisable to consider  
whether home rule for Cuba is not the best  
solution."

A dispatch from Madrid to the Standard  
says that the papers there publish some  
curious statistics as to the cost of the  
Cuban war. Nearly 118,000 men have been  
sent to the island and the cost of the rebel-  
lion has already amounted to ten million  
pounds (\$50,000,000), and for the second year  
it will exceed \$50,000,000. The  
Standard's correspondent says that Captain  
General Weyler reports that it will take  
at least two years to crush the rebellion.  
The Chronicle, in an editorial, thinks that  
a view of the concurrent resolution, Cap-

tain General Weyler's action and the ap-  
proach of the presidential election, Presi-  
dent Cleveland will not hesitate long. "The  
seriousness of the situation created," the  
Chronicle goes on to say, "cannot be well  
estimated. It is not conceivable that  
Spain should agree to give independence to  
Cuba. It is equally difficult to see what  
effectual opposition she could offer if the  
United States determined to follow its good  
office action. The American govern-  
ment, however, is resting on a shabby  
road at the bidding of Congress. We sup-  
pose that it fully recognizes all the respon-  
sibilities that it is proposing to incur."

**GOOD PRICES FOR PAINTINGS.**

One sold for \$25,200, Another for \$21,500, and a Rembrandt for \$18,000.

NEW YORK, Feb. 28.—The famous collection  
of paintings owned by the late William  
Shaues was sold to-night at Chokering  
Hall by auctioneer Thomas Kirby. A large  
crowd was in attendance, and some unusu-  
ally high prices were paid for paintings.  
Bossard's "Edge of the Woods" when ex-  
hibited for sale was greeted with applause,  
and the bidding started at \$1,000. The painting  
was finally knocked down at \$2,300.  
Rembrandt's "Portrait of an Admiral" is  
said to be a true portrait of the Dutch  
Admiral Van Tromp. This canvas went for  
\$2,600. "The Fisherman," by Frans Hals,  
depicting a fisherman, by Frans Hals, de-  
picting a fisherman, which was painted in  
1668, and which is a very lifelike and  
vigorous picture of a fisherman, was sold  
for \$3,500. "Le Retour a la Ferme," a  
superb example of Troyon's landscape  
lovely in its sunlight glow, with a number  
of cattle, sold for \$24,500. Another painting  
by the same master entitled "The Pasture"  
sold for \$10,000. "Sunset," by Diaz, one  
of the most beautiful in the collection,  
which shows low-lying marsh lands, with  
a sky that is a marvel of expression, sold  
for \$18,000.

The best paintings are the ones that  
brought the highest prices, but all the rest  
sold at prices running up into the thousands.  
As but very few of them sold for less than  
\$1,000, a few of these exceptions being  
"Bank of a Stream," by Bossard, which  
was sold for \$500 and "Cattle in a Field,"  
by Freere, sold for \$225, and "Italian Youth  
with Fan," by Lefebvre, for \$175. The total  
receipts from the sale were \$37,825. The  
purchasers were Herman Schaus, who  
bought "Edge of the Woods" for \$2,300,  
"Coucher de Soleil," by Daubigny, for \$10,000,  
"The Halberdier," by Melsheimer, for \$2,600,  
and several others. W. H. Grabber, who  
bought "The Italian Beauty," a A. H. G. got  
"Landscape Study in Brown," by Rossard,  
and four other paintings, while the rest of  
the paintings went to dealers who bought  
on orders. The sale, said Mr. Kirby,  
"was entirely satisfactory, and one of the  
greatest I ever had."

City Sanitarian Ferguson yesterday had a  
sample of water from School No. 25 which  
he had been requested to test for impurities.  
It was yellow and dirty-looking and would  
impress the ordinary observer as being very  
bad water. Its appearance was surely  
against it. He tested it for chlorides and  
for nitrates, which are the two things that  
indicate unhealthful water. He was not the  
least bit surprised when the tests failed to  
show any chlorides or nitrates. The indica-
