

THE KING A WINNER CAPTURED THE 2:11 TROT IN THREE STRAIGHT HEATS. Charlie Mc, McKinney's Son, Broke Near the Wire and Could Not Get Better than Second Money.

LEAFY WON THE 2:25 PACE STRAIGHT HEATS WERE TAKEN BY OAKWOOD'S DAUGHTER.

Darkey Got Second Money—The 2:17 Pace Was Unfinished—To-day's Events Began at 12 o'clock.

Sundown last evening found the last event unfinished on the programme of races at the State fair, and it was necessary to postpone the finish until to-day. It was the 2:17 pace, which drew a field of sixteen starters, and only three heats were paced before dark. Red Patchen took the first heat, and the second and third heats were won by Ax. This race will be the first on the programme at the fair to-day, and as there are five other big events on the card, all of which are well filled, the races will begin promptly at 12 o'clock, and there will be no interruption. The officials hope to conclude the entire programme before nightfall.

Yesterday was another ideal day for racing, and when the big field of starters in the three events got the word from Starter McDonald, after many tiresome delays in each heat, the spectators were treated to some sensational miles. The finishes in all the heats were exciting, and in several heats three and four horses went under the wire abreast. The track was in perfect condition, and the other conditions were ideal. Probably the best performance of the afternoon were the miles by Ax, the son of Axel, when he won the second and third heats of the unfinished 2:17 pace in 2:09. Leafy made a good mark by taking the 2:25 pace in three heats, one of which was made in 2:09. The King, the winner of the 2:11 trot, also secured a new mark by taking the second heat in 2:04.

BIG CROWD PRESENT. The grand stand and betting ring were crowded during the afternoon, while the fences on both sides of the track on the stretch were lined with spectators. It was a big day for the fair.

an appreciative crowd, and although the majority of those in the stand, all the spectators rose to their feet when the steppers were seen leaving the track. So large was the field of starters in the various heats that accidents were looked for, but there were none. The few delays caused by the disarrangement of harness before some of the heats and a few "bad actors" made catching, but careful driving prevented any collisions. The first event on the card was the 2:25 pace, which drew a field of seventeen starters. Leafy, by Oakwood, a pretty bay mare, was a favorite, and she captured the second heat. Charlie Mc, McKinney's son, gave her the hardest drive for the wire in each heat and always managed to get a close second. He was also urged in the first heat and was very close third. Leafy and Darkey were a tandem battle in the second heat, but they came down the home stretch nose and nose, Leafy drawing under the wire, and he was the black horse. The third heat of this race also furnished an exciting finish, but Leafy won with Darkey a half length better out of the bunch and made a game finish for the wire, but could not get better than third.

THE 2:11 TROT. The 2:11 trot furnished three exciting heats, all of which were taken by the King, the bay gelding by Clay King. But the King had a hard race for the wire in each heat. Charlie Mc, by McKinney, gave the King a hard argument, and but for unfortunate breaks in two of the heats would no doubt have won. After the first heat the King was a half length better out of 3 to 10, and it was by mere luck that the talent was able to "clean up" on him in the second heat. Charlie Mc, however, better in the second heat and trotted beside the King along the back stretch with several feet to spare. The King was urged of the procession. As the last turn was made the King and Charlie Mc, drew a slight lead over the favorite, Lily Young, who was coming down the stretch a close third, but was able to get alongside the two leaders. EXPANSION OF CREDITS. Interesting Address to Business Men by Volney W. Foster. CHICAGO, Sept. 17.—The Credit Men's Association of this city gave a banquet at the Auditorium to-night and had as guests ex-Congressman Charles G. Dawes, who spoke of "Credit Expansion of the United States," and Volney W. Foster, whose topic was "Expansion of Our Credits." Mr. Foster said in part: "I believe that it is true of nations as of individuals that those who live for themselves are the most successful. It is not necessary to consider this as the very nature of our growth and development will compel consideration of the part of the earth which must come in touch with us. We have been successful in our own necessities to a commensurate degree. Our boundaries have been changed, our opportunities made on the part of our responsibilities have increased. Urged by as righteous indignation as ever moved a nation, we have become torch-bearers to dark Africa, and the few evil incidents that have accrued in our administration of this trust have been the result of our own selfishness and our own narrowness of vision. At any time since the birth of the man of Nazareth that the spirit of His gospel has been in the world, and it is not believed that there are its manifestations more evident than in our own beautiful country. We are acting in obedience to the great law of the soul's gravitation, and grasping hands are loosened of their burden as we raise them in reverent adoration to its great light. What an opportunity to direct nations to happiness and peace, to steal from them, Africa, to steal away despair and to steal radiant beautiful hope in its place; to deal ignorance and to give wisdom; to steal disease and kill its horrid germs; to steal all that makes for misery and to give all that makes for hope. It is a class distinction, hereditary rules, inviolable and complicated laws, the enormous cost of respective governments all act as hindrance to the best results of the labor of other nations.
