## A Bit of History.

In early times Sugar creek, though now placid in its flow, was regarded by many as unsafe and treacherous. Before the day of bridges when travelers must cross by "fording," death by drowning was no uncommon occurrence. At places usually regarded as safe, the current after heavy rains would quickly become so swift as to be dangerous, and sometimes sweep both horse and rider down to the bottom of the creek. The father of Joseph G. Cannon, next speaker of the House of Representatives, drowned about three miles west of this place, in trying to cross Sugar creek at the Rockport ford. This was in the late summer of 1850. Joseph G. Cannon was then a lad of fourteen. Dr. Cannon lived in the little village of Annapolis, and enjoyed wide practice in his profession. He was brave and daring, in the prime of life, and when summoned to the bedside of a patient living "across" the creek started at once to the man's relief.  
 By the time the physician found the ford, the swollen stream was rushing over the rocks, and the doctor was in danger. He was warned by Dr. Cannon of the danger in attempting to cross, but he would not be deterred, and urged his horse into the water. For a time it seemed he would succeed, but suddenly the horse was swept by the swirling waters over the strength of his horse, swept Dr. Cannon from his seat, and he was carried down the creek and on down the Washah for miles. Strange as it may seem the horse escaped.  
 The swollen stream was regarded by a few people with a superstitious fear. A powerful undertone of belief in the death of the unwary swimmer. In fact, through the three-quarters of a century since, white men have been afraid to wade in the water. Swimmers have lost their lives.  
 But now Sugar Creek is a perfectly well-behaved stream, and a pleasure of water, though ample for boating and swimming, is not nearly so great as formerly.

**WARSAW, Ind., Aug. 22.**—The summer season at Winona lake is drawing to a close and the regular summer visitors are leaving the ground by hundreds every day. Notwithstanding this fact the largest attendance in the history of the park is now registered and every room on the grounds is occupied. The ninth annual Winona Bible Conference, Aug. 16 to 27, has brought people from all parts of the world to Winona, and for the next few days the park will be crowded to its utmost capacity. It has been necessary to provide sleeping quarters in the entrance building, the house and even the offices in order to accommodate the vast crowd that has been present for the past week, a conservative estimate of which is from 6,000 to 8,000.  
 The conference has been the most successful one in the history of the meetings, and Rev. J. Wilbur Chapman, the founder and director of the conference, is highly elated with the success which has crowned his efforts. During the week a number of church organizations have held special meetings in conjunction with the conference meetings, and a religious atmosphere pervades the entire assembly ground.
