The first column denotes the pay per month of artillery and infantry, and of dragoons and riflemen when serving on foot. The second column denotes the pay per month of light artillery and of dragoons and riflemen when mounted. Sergeant Major, Quartermaster, Chief of Police, Principal Musician, Chief Clerk, Chaplain, First Sergeant of a Company, Ordnance Sergeants, Hospital Stewards, etc., 17 00. Corporals... 14 00. Buglers... 13 00. Musicians... 12 00. Farriers and Blacksmiths... 15 00. Artificers... 17 00. Privates... 13 00. Matron... 6 00. Females nurses 40 cents per day and one ration. Paymaster's Clerks \$700 per annum, and 75 cents per day when actually on duty. Chaplain in volunteers \$146 50. In addition to the pay as above stated, one ration per day and an abundant supply of good clothing is allowed to every soldier. Quarters, fuel and medical attendance are also provided by the Government without deduction from the soldier's pay. If a soldier should become disabled in the line of his duties, the law provides for him a pension, or may, if he prefers, obtain admission into the Military Academy, which will afford him a comfortable home so long as he may wish to receive its benefits. To the above pay for private soldiers must be added the additional \$2 a month to be paid during service, the \$100 bounty at the end of the war, which has already been provided for, and the quarter section of land that Congress will provide for at its coming session. The bounty and land apply to officers and privates alike.
