FROM THE 72d REGIMENT—One of the editors of the Lafayette Courier, writing from Lebanon, Kentucky, where the 72d was stationed on the 18th inst., says: We found at this place the 60th Indiana regiment, Col. Barbarities of War—Abolition England preaches her philanthropy, but no nation under the sun has sanctioned such barbarities as she has. Her hiring Indians to scalp the helpless settlers on her frontiers during the war of 1812 was exceeded by her treatment of the rebellious Seeps in 1857. So late as 1859 she stands by and gives up prisoners to the most cruel tortures. The following extract from a letter written by an English soldier, describing an action between the English and Imperials against the Tapings in China, in 1859, pictures a sickening scene of horror: I went with the crowd to see the execution of the Taping prisoners that had been given up for execution into the hands of the Mandarins by the English and French authorities, and which, as a matter of course, gushed out, but the cut was made in such a way and so skillfully, and with such expertise, that the intestines were seldom injured. After a little time in this state of excessive torture, the executioner thrust his hand into the chest and tore out the reeking heart, his victim looking him in the face all the while.
