The Call for One Hundred Days' Service—To the Public.

INDIANAPOLIS, IND., April 26, 1864.

The tender of troops from Western States, will enable the Government to employ the Army of the Potomac and Cumberland entire, while protecting the border States, fundamental lines against such diversions of the enemy through Western Virginia or Eastern or Western Kentucky as threaten our deep lines of communication with the front.

The Indiana Legion and the people of this State have fresh opportunity to render valuable services and to familiarize themselves with arms.

Experience proves that as large armies advance by a front so extended as that from the Atlantic to the Mississippi, no single command can cover all access to its rear, and that a desperate enemy, pressed back and daily restricted in its field operations, will attempt to force its way at points isolated from advanced columns, for purposes of supplies, or offensive action.

The present call contemplates a special force to guard against such contingencies, and enable the Government to concentrate its veteran troops at vital points of struggle.

The rapid movement of these reserves may be rendered more effective by the opening of summer as will render the autumn operations decisive of the whole struggle.

The changing issues of war forbid us to expect that Federal arms can, at all points, under all circumstances, be rendered more effective, as it is the part of wisdom to anticipate mingled success and repulse; but, with the evidence derived from the rebel policy itself, that they are feeling the weight of our arms and losing substantial lines and strongholds, we are called upon to hasten our movements, and to give to our arms the reserves as will turn all temporary disaster into permanent victory.

This appeals directly to every business man. Our confidence in final victory begets a disregard of individual responsibility, and in the wealth of our resources and numerical strength, we are as some final result without fitting first the individual measure of duty. No citizen can fail to aid the cause if he will deal with this matter as with other business. If he cannot go, let him send his money and still pay his wages and hold his place open. Thus, all will do their part, at home or in the field.

I shall take personal charge of the instruction and discipline of these troops, and trust that in every case they will be prompt and willing as under every call hitherto made.

III. Marching honors will be paid to the Governor of Indiana while passing the State House.

IV. The division will enter Washington street from New Jersey street, at 2 o'clock precisely, at which time the line must be fully formed.

V. The staff will report at No. 115 North New Jersey street, at 1 o'clock precisely.

REAPERS AND MOWERS.

THE BUCKEYE REAPER AND MOWER
