THE LIBERALS VICTORIOUS. THE ATLANTIC CABLE.

Later from Europe. New York, July 26.—The steamer Scotia, from Liverpool on the 15th, and Queenstown on the 16th, has arrived.

The ship Mercury at Havre, from New York on the 26th of June, picked up additional passengers from the William Nelson, and five more from pieces of the wreck. A bark was visible, and it is hoped she saved others.

The Great Eastern was expected to leave Valencia on the 15th. An Antwerp paper rejoices that Antwerp is to become a permanent station for American war vessels.

The elections engross the attention of England. The Liberals had 263 and the Conservatives 158—a Liberal gain thus far.

Another week will elapse before all the election will be over. The Mercantile Bank of New York obtained in the Queen's Bench a verdict for \$26,733 against Charles Winslow, who lately absconded.

The Swiss Federal Council received notice of the recall of Mr. Fogg, the American Minister, and the substitution of Mr. Harrington.

LIVERPOOL, July 15.—News unimportant. Not much electrification to-day. The Astor's news imparts considerable excitement to the cotton market to-day, and improves American securities, especially Illinois.

Thunder-storm in Cincinnati—Prize Fight Stopped. CINCINNATI, July 26.—A thunder-storm yesterday evening did considerable damage to property in this neighborhood.

The prize fight, for \$1,000 a side, between Clark and Keating, which was to have come off to-day, has been indefinitely postponed by the arrest of Keating, who is held in ten thousand dollars bail.
