A Review of the Decision of Judge Paine, in the Case of the SEIZURE AND LIBERATION OF MR. LEMMON'S SLAVES.

In England, now so distinguished by the abolition of slavery, no question of the legality of holding slaves appears to have been raised; but, every possible proof is found that it was considered as on the same footing as any commerce.

All nations were eager to seize the opportunity of deriving profit from this traffic (as late as in the year 1783). It was even asserted upon the floor of Parliament "to be necessary, in a commercial view," and was not considered inconsistent with the rights of humanity or the laws of nations.

In the year 1688, England made a regular convention with Spain for supplying the Spanish West Indies with negro slaves from the island of Jamaica.

The treaty of Utrecht, the treaty of Madrid, the treaty of Vienna, and the treaty of Amiens, all contain articles which confirm the right of the British to supply the Spanish West Indies with negro slaves.

Among the Germans slavery was recognized as one of the principles of national law. [Woll de Nat. Rel. 201; Molloy de Marit. lib. 3, chap. 1.]
