TELEGRAPHED TO THE CRESCENT. Memphis Convention.

MEMPHIS, June 8. THIRD DAY—EVENING SESSION.—The Convention met this afternoon, pursuant to adjournment, and after several resolutions reported by the Committee, passing most of them without any material change. No other business of moment was done before adjournment. Tomorrow the Convention will be addressed by the Hon. John M. McKim.

Land-Office Case.

THE case of Sigur vs. Brown, contesting the right to the office of the Land Register of the State, was concluded this morning by the Judge rendering his decision. MEMPHIS CONVENTION—OCEAN STEAMERS—STATE LEGISLATURE—SHIP CANALS—WATER FILTRATION, ETC. It is now a matter of certainty that the representation from Baltimore and Maryland in the Memphis Convention will be but a sparse one in numbers, and in weight and influence entirely out of proportion to the interest which we are supposed to have in the deliberations and conclusions of that body. Some two or three gentlemen have left here for Memphis within the last few days, but the efforts to send a numerous and influential delegation have entirely failed.

THE ARABIA'S TRIP.

Our contemporaries are chronicling, in every direction, the recent trip of the Cunard steamer Arabia from New York to Liverpool and back, as a very remarkable thing, and some of them foolishly say that the Collins boats are now beaten. This is not true in any respect. The Arabia has undoubtedly made a very fine run. She was ten days, two hours and forty-five minutes in running from Liverpool to New York; or fifteen minutes less time than any other Cunard vessel has ever made the same trip. She also beat the last trip of the Arctic some six or seven hours. But the victory, even granting all that is demanded, and making no qualifications on account of weather, is only a victory over the other boats of the Cunard line, and over one single unfortunate trip of the Arctic. The Arctic made the same run, from Liverpool to New York, in February, 1852, in nine days, seventeen hours and forty-five minutes, or five hours less time than the Arabia has done; and there is not a single vessel in the Collins line which has not performed the same trip in from four to sixteen and a half hours less time than the Arabia ever did.
