Washington correspondent of the Philadelphia North American writes: There has been no fatal danger among members of Congress since that between Mr. Gillis and Mr. Graves, in 1837.

Probably the next affair in the order of time was the personal quarrel between Mr. Benton and Mr. Butler, in which, after the 'Miss' was given, a personal assault was made on the amendment of Texas, and then the identity was adjusted by apologies and regrets.

During the excitement which ended with the compromise of 1850, two personal affairs arose which nearly cost the lives of two of our countrymen. The first was that between Col. Bissell, of Illinois, and Col. Jefferson Davis, of Mississippi.

Such a brief record of Congressional belligerency for the last thirteen years, it is obvious that, while the babble of quarreling remains, the practice of fighting is going, or rather has gone, to the ground.

Some of these cases are of interest, to show what might have been, had not the necessity for the defense, been impressed on him by a blow which we should have supposed to have been an interval for thought.

As much as Mr. Clay's name has been frequently mentioned in the recent debates on the Nebraska bill, I feel to be due to his memory as well as to the truth of history to give to the public the following recollections.
