Cotton Firm - Breadstuffs Quiet. Later from Sebastopol - Another Battle. EXPLOSION OF A RUSSIAN FORT.

New York, Nov. 15. - The Cunard steamer Asia has arrived here, bringing dates from Liverpool of the 4th instant, three days later than the accounts brought by the American.

Liverpool Markets. - There has been only a moderate demand for Cotton here since the departure of the Atlantic, and the sale of the entire week took barely 47,000 bales, of which 20,000 have been taken for speculation and about 4,000 for export.

According to the shipments of some of the wounded officers of the Russians, who had been taken to Balaklava, Sebastopol would soon be in the hands of the Allies. In the mean time, Lord Raglan prefers to continue the bombardment, rather than make a sudden assault.

Reinforcements - Spy Detected. - Both the Russian and Allied armies had received further reinforcements to a considerable extent. Lord Raglan's chief interpreter, a Greek, had been discovered to be a Russian spy, and had been sent to Constantinople for trial.

Money and Trade. - The Money market at London has been without any change of moment. Messrs. Baring, Bros & Co. report a moderate demand for American stocks at unchanged rates.

General News. - Several young men have just joined the military ministry. They promise to be distinguished. For the education of the Russian army at Danville, Ky.

Important Battle. - The latest advice from Sebastopol report that a force of 30,000 Russians had made an attack upon, and recaptured one of the forts occupied by the Allies, and that a great battle had been fought near Balaklava, in which the Russians had been driven back, and the Allies remained in possession of the field.

Arrival from Bermuda. - A vessel here has just arrived from Bermuda, bringing dates from that island to the 8th inst. Her advice state that a British ship of the line had sailed for San Juan, and that the British fleet was concentrating at the latter place.

Election in Kentucky. - BALTIMORE, Nov. 16. - The election in the Third Congressional District in this State for a member of Congress in the place of the late Francis Pickens has resulted in the choice of the Whig candidate, Brantley.

Know-Nothing Convention. - BALTIMORE, Nov. 16. - Nothing is yet known with regard to the proceedings of the National Convention of the Know-Nothings, now in session at Cincinnati. It is understood, however, that a candidate for the Presidency will be nominated by them, and that the principal candidates before them are Millard Fillmore, John M. Clayton and Sam Houston.

Passengers by the Asia. - NEW YORK, Nov. 16. - Among the passengers brought by the Asia are Mr. George F. Weiser, of the Bee, and twelve other persons belonging to New Orleans.

New York Election. - NEW YORK, Nov. 16. - The table of the election returns in the Times of this city, increases Clark's majority for Governor to 805. It is not yet certain that Clark is elected, however, as all the returns are not received.

Delaware Election. - BALTIMORE, Nov. 15. - The returns of the election in Delaware are nearly complete. Peter F. Causy, the American candidate for Governor, has been elected by about 1000 majority, and Eliza D. Collier, on the same ticket, is chosen for Congress by a majority of 800.

Cincinnati Banks. - BALTIMORE, Nov. 15. - The notes of the Mechanics and Traders' Bank of Cincinnati are taken on deposit by the other branches of the State Bank of Ohio, as the latter is bound for their redemption.

Ohio River - Markets - Bank Troubles. - PITTSBURGH, Nov. 15. - The river here is now rising, with 21 inches water in the channel. CINCINNATI, Nov. 15. - The river here has fallen 3 inches during the last 24 hours.

New York Markets. - NEW YORK, Nov. 15. - The demand for Cotton in this market is yet quite limited. Middling Orleans is quoted at 94c per lb. Flour is active, and prices have advanced, with sales of Ohio brands at 68c to 69c per bushel.

Sailing of the Arabia. - NEW YORK, Nov. 15. - The Cunard steamer Arabia sailed at noon, to-day, for Liverpool, taking out \$1,280,000 in specie.

Battle at Balaklava. - NEW YORK, Nov. 15. - The Asia reached here this morning at nine o'clock. Her papers contain the following interesting intelligence: THE RECENT BATTLE. - The Russian dispatches state that the Allies had suffered two severe defeats near Sebastopol.
