THE AMERICAN PARTY OF LOUISIANA.

1. We advocate a restoration of the National Union, with proper safeguards to preserve the purity of the elective franchise.

2. We advocate the passage of such laws as will prevent the immigration of paupers and criminals into this country.

3. We advocate any interference in the vested rights of all persons, whether they be native or foreign born.

4. We advocate the passage of such laws as will prevent the immigration of paupers and criminals into this country.

5. We advocate a high National Policy, such as will afford secure and unobstructed protection to the American manufacturer, and will favor and guard the American merchant.

6. We believe that America should be governed by Americans, electing the same through the ballot-box, the only legitimate franchise of man in this country.

7. We believe that the office should seek the man, and not the man seek the office, and that the distribution of offices should be made as a reward for permanent services.

8. We will maintain and defend the Constitution of the United States, the Union as it now exists, and the rights of the States without distinction, insisting upon a faithful performance on the part of the General Government of all the duties enjoined upon it by the Constitution.

9. While we approve of the platform adopted by the late National Convention of the American party, at Philadelphia, we reserve the application of the details of the platform to the American people, as they may see fit.
