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THOUGHTS ON THE LATE ELECTION BILL.

BY A CITIZEN OF NEW ORLEANS.

The 12th Article of the Constitution vests in the citizens of the city of New Orleans the right of appointing the several public officers necessary for the administration of the police of said city, pursuant to the mode of elections which shall be prescribed by the Legislature.

The terms "pursuant to the mode of elections which shall be prescribed by the Legislature," refer to a mode of election, directly by the people, or indirectly by them.

A right conferred by the Constitution in clear and express terms, can not be taken away or rendered null by an Act of the Legislature.

The administration of the police of the city means, simply, the enforcement of the laws and regulations for the government, peace, good order and welfare of the people of the city.

The unconstitutional character of the act vesting exclusive authority, under the Central Board of Commissioners, in the Superintendent of Elections, is still further manifested from the provision of the 12th Article of the Constitution.

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
