BLACK REPUBLICAN BOLDNESS.

About a month ago Horace Greeley, editor of the New York Tribune, delivered a speech in Kansas Territory, in which he openly avowed that it was the purpose of the party of which he is the acknowledged editorial head in the Northern States, not to content themselves with anything less than an enforcement of their political theories in the very center of the Southern States. That was the ultimate object of their organization, and he was confident of ultimate success. This is, substantially, what Senator Seward said in the United States Senate; and in his Troy and Rochester speeches of last year, made respectively four and five days before the New York State election, which resulted in transferring into the hands of his personal friends and associates the government of that mighty commonwealth.

MODERN WARFARE.

The wicked invention is described in detail and copiously enlarged upon as a very meritorious thing, and men read the account with deep interest, they thought never once occurring to them that they are enjoying a sort of food, and a pleasure because a new and a bloodier means for the destruction of the human race, perhaps of themselves individually, has been discovered. To no department of science and mechanism does so much and so general interest attach as to warlike mechanism—mechanism of which the object is the destruction of human life; and so universal is the gratification expressed when a marked improvement is made, that other great matters are scarcely alluded to show that the great majority of men are slayers of their kind at heart; they are ruthless, savage creatures, more worthy praise when they violate their nature and save life, than they are worthy blame when they obey their instincts, and take life.

Anniversary Events—July 27.

1856—The steamer John Jay, running on the Lake George, took fire on her passage from the landing near Ticonderoga to Caldwell, and was consumed, by which several of the passengers and crew perished. 1844—John Dalton, an eminent English chemist, died, aged 78. He had devoted his whole life to his profession. A public funeral was given him in Manchester, his native town. He worshipped with the Friends. He could distinguish both colors yellow and blue, red and green had the same appearance to his eye. 1840—Charlotte Oellett, a Canadian heroine, died, aged 106. She was one of a number of young women of St. Ann's de la Tourette, who put on men's apparel and armed themselves to drive out the British regulars who were assuming themselves by firing the houses and barns of the village, during the siege of Quebec. She and the rest of her company fired upon the English, who, seeing, making temporary barrows in their flight, to reach those who fell under the fire of these brave Canadian girls. A few days previous to her death she indulged in treatment at the thought that she was about to die, and she died on the 27th of July, 1840. 1833—William Buhldinger, an American Commodore, died, aged 60. He was a distinguished Commander in the navy for a long series of years. 1830—The second French revolution began in Paris by a resistance of the decree of Charles X. It burst forth on the following day, and continued three days, when the people were left disappointed masters of the capital. About 3000 victims fell in this struggle. 1800—First day's battle of Talavera; Wellington made a stand against the French army of Donon's 60,000 men, under Jourdan, Victor and Mortier. 1806—The United States Exploring Expedition, under Capt. Lewis, had their guns seized while asleep, by a party of Minutemen Indians. One of the Indians was stabbed to the heart, and Lewis shot the body of the man who fell on his knees and allowed himself to be fired; the bear and the head. The remainder of the Indians fled, leaving the explorers in possession of their baggage, provisions, and four horses. 1799—Mantua, with a garrison of 10,000 men, dishonorably surrendered to the Austrians. 1794—Oresther of Kobopierre and the Mountain party, which put an end to the reign of terror. 1794—The British fleet, which had been defeated in the bay of Quiberon, was destroyed by the British, which claimed the victory. British loss 133; 374. French loss 105; 529. 1775—Congress established a hospital for 20,000 men, and appointed Benjamin Church director and physician general. 1774—Samuel Theophilus Gemelli, a German baptist, died. He was Professor of botany at St. Peter's, Rome, and employed in the French army in the province bordering on the Caspian sea; was detained a prisoner by a Tartar chief, in which situation he died. 1700—The legislative union of England and Scotland completed; one of the most important events of the reign of Queen Anne. 1700—Stanislus Leszczinski elected King of Poland. 1684—The charter of the Bank of England, for twelve years, determinable upon one year's notice, signed by the Dynarch, William and Mary. 1675—Henry de la Tour d'Auvergne, Viscount de Turenne, the renowned French General, killed by a cannon shot at the village of Salzbach, in Germany.
