Local Intelligence

The weather yesterday was another delightful bright and beautiful day.

The Clay Monument. The erection of the Clay statue, in Canal street, on the 12th April, will cause the part of the population, from all we can hear, on the subject of the monument, to be very much interested.

The Monument Association has made every arrangement to render the celebration one worthy of this city. Wm. H. Hunt, Esq., has been chosen editor of the monument, and Col. J. G. Seymour, editor of the Bulletin, has been chosen for Grand Marshal.

The beginning of the work on Canal street arrests the attention of crowds daily. The builder of the pedestal is Mr. Newton Richards. He is now laying the foundation, within the large circle which is already laid out and curbed. The style of the monument will be this: A flagged footway all around, six feet wide; a flight of five steps all around, in octagonal shape, ascending to an octagonal pedestal; all this, of neatly trimmed granite.

The Rev. Canon of the Cathedral, rector of St. Peter's Church, in the Third District, is bringing the arrangements for the building of his new church to the practical point. The plan of the church has been drawn up by Messrs. Howard & Dietel, the architects, and adopted.

We have taken a look at the drawings, and find that the church will be an elegant and commodious brick edifice, capable of seating over 700 people. It will be erected on Crisp street, near the railroad. It will have a front of 75 feet and a depth of 121 feet. It will be of the Romanesque style of architecture; a most showy and elegant form, with a small tower at one corner, and a large and tall tower and spire at the other corner; the extreme height, from the earth to the top of the cross on the spire, being 175 feet. Inside, the finishings will not be splendid or costly, but will be neat and elegant, and well suited to the needs of the congregation.
