POLITICAL MOVEMENTS - PRESENT ASPECT OF THE CANVASS.

Within the last few days it has become evident that the Douglas wing of the Democracy has plucked up courage, and is about to make a bold move in the case in the South.

The Chairman of the National Democratic Convention at Washington is the Hon. Miles Taylor, of this State, who, as our readers will know, is a distinguished and influential member of Congress.

But the most significant sign of the times is the pronouncement recently issued by the National Committee at Washington, signed by Hon. Miles Taylor, Chairman, in which the fact of a fusion of the two wings of the Democracy upon a common ticket is scouted and repelled with something very much like a feeling of indignation.

As far as is known to the members of the resident Democratic Convention, no person who supports the fusion of the two wings of the Democracy for no person who desires the election of Stephen A. Douglas to the Presidency, and of Herschel V. Johnson to the Vice Presidency, has ever expressed a wish for any such arrangement, or entailed, or even countenanced, for a single moment, any suggestion or proposition tending towards it.

Such is the ticket which, amid the clouds that overhang the Democracy, appears as the "ray of promise" to the eyes of the people. The Democratic party is no longer contented if it ever was to save the South, or to save the Union.

Now is the auspicious moment for the people of all sections of the country, and of all varieties of conservative political faith, to rally to the standard of Bell and Everett. In the South, with the Democracy divided between Douglas and Breckinridge, it is almost impossible to project the electoral vote of nearly every Southern State being given to Bell and Everett.
