ADJOURNMENT OF THE CONVENTION. The Louisiana Convention yesterday adjourned sine die, and most of the members are, ere this, on their way to their respective homes.

The two leading and most significant acts of the Convention were the passage of the Ordinance of Secession, and the renunciation of the Constitution of the Confederate States.

The vote in each case was nearly unanimous. By both of these Acts, promptly performed, Louisiana has repudiated the Abolitionist's charge that she was indifferent to her own rights, and that she did not respect her own rights, and that she did not respect her own rights.

Next in importance, in the grand march, was the renunciation of the Constitution of the Confederate States. The vote in each case was nearly unanimous.

The Convention itself was composed of the leading citizens of the State—men eminent for their talents, their virtues and their courage, and representatives of the wealth of the State as well as of its intelligence.

Their proceedings were conducted with dignity and harmony. They have answered to the expectations of the people, and they will receive that welcome to the people's hands which is the highest recognition of a faithful discharge of the representative trust. We extend to each member, at parting, our cordial good wishes.

REUNION OF ARMY OFFICERS. Since the cause of secession has received so great an impetus by the withdrawal of Louisiana, the resignation of army and naval officers under the old United States Government have been constant, and appear to be increasing.

In looking over a list, a short time since, we noticed the names of Col. Henry Wilson, of the 7th Infantry, U. S. A., and Col. W. H. W. Wilson, of the 1st U. S. Cavalry, Louisiana. For over forty years he was connected with the Army of the United States, frequently on duty in Louisiana and the Western frontier. He was detailed as Governor of Vera Cruz, during the Mexican war.

For several of the late United States have performed greater service and been subject to more peril than Col. Wilson. During the ever-memorable campaign of South Carolina in December last, he resigned his commission in the late United States Army, and it is hoped that he will not be overlooked by the Administration of the Confederate States. He is emphatically one of us, a real true Southerner, connected by marriage with the ancient families of Louisiana. Like many other gallant and noble souls, who would not bear arms against their kindred, he redoubled his patriotism against the impolicy of the great contest in which the South is now engaged.
