AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO ISSUE THE BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION OF DOLLARS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SAME, TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MILITARY SERVICE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONTRACTS MADE BY HIM AND THE FEDERAL COMMISSIONERS, AUTHORIZED FOR THAT PURPOSE.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Louisiana, in General Assembly convened, That the Governor of this State is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of the State, to be signed by him, and countersigned by the Secretary of State, and sealed with the seal of the State, in sums as he shall think proper, up to the amount of one million of dollars payable in twenty years, and bearing interest, payable semi-annually, at the rate of eight per centum per annum...

SECTION 2. Be it further enacted, etc., That if during the term, the proceeds of the sale of the Public or Swamp Lands belonging to the State so pledged for the redemption of said bonds after reserving an amount sufficient to meet the interest coupons, there should be a surplus, said surplus shall be applied to the purchase from the lowest bidder of such bonds issued under this act, and the Governor and the Commissioners or a majority of them, shall have the right of rejecting all bids, demanding more than the face of the bonds, for which purpose, public notice shall be given by the Governor in the official gazette and one other gazette in or out of the State, for any day, having regard to the fact that the bonds are to be sold to the highest bidder, here in described.

SECTION 3. Be it further enacted, etc., That in the event of the sale of the Public or Swamp Lands belonging to the State so pledged for the redemption of said bonds after reserving an amount sufficient to meet the interest coupons, there should be a surplus, said surplus shall be applied to the purchase from the lowest bidder of such bonds issued under this act, and the Governor and the Commissioners or a majority of them, shall have the right of rejecting all bids, demanding more than the face of the bonds, for which purpose, public notice shall be given by the Governor in the official gazette and one other gazette in or out of the State, for any day, having regard to the fact that the bonds are to be sold to the highest bidder, here in described.

SECTION 4. SECTION 5. That this act shall take effect from and after date.
