New Orleans, May 17, 1866. In conformity to the provisions of an act of the General Assembly, entitled: An act to authorize the Governor to issue the Bonds of the State for the amount of one Million of Dollars, and to provide for the payment of the same, to defray the expenses of building levees, in accordance with the contracts made by him and the levee commissioners appointed for that purpose.
