WASHINGTON, July 24.—The President has signed the joint resolution admitting Tennessee, but says the preamble consists of statements, some of which are assumed, while the resolution is merely a declaration of opinion; it confers no legislative power upon the President, and he is earnestly desirous to remove every cause of further delay; he would rather resign than to be considered as committing him to all the statements of the preamble, some of which are without foundation.
