The Commissioner of Internal Revenue has just issued the following important regulations...

Regulations Concerning Cotton

Under bond and permit, as aforesaid, shall be delivered to the collector of internal revenue...

Regulations Concerning Cotton

Section 3. The collector of internal revenue to designate places in each collection district where an assessor or an assistant assessor, and a collector or a deputy collector, shall be located...

Regulations Concerning Cotton

Under the proviso of section 3, the owner of cotton may have it weighed and marked wherever it may be in the district, provided he pays the necessary traveling expenses...

Regulations Concerning Cotton

In order to prevent confusion in the assessment and collection of cotton, the collector of internal revenue has required that each person for whom cotton has been weighed and marked...
