Circular Instructions About Smuggling.

REWARD FOR THE ARREST OF WALKER'S HUSBANDS.

Washington, Oct. 3.--The President has pardoned Albert G. Brown, formerly United States Senator from Mississippi, and Gen. Humphrey Marshall, of Kentucky.

Washington, Oct. 3.--A circular of instruction has just been issued from the treasury department, to carry into effect the provisions of the seventeenth section of the act to prevent smuggling, approved July 15, 1886.

The section provides that whenever the proper officer of the customs shall be duly notified of the existence of a lien upon imported goods, wares or merchandise in his custody, he shall, before delivering such goods, wares or merchandise to the importer, contract or consignee, give reasonable notice to the party or parties claiming the lien, and the possession by the officers of customs shall not affect the discharge of such lien, provided the right of the government shall not be prejudiced thereby.

Under the instructions issued persons claiming a lien for any customs imposed goods in the possession of a collector or chief officer of customs, may serve a written or printed notice upon him, which notice shall designate the goods and packages particularly as possible, giving the names of the owners, importers or consignees, the vessel or vessels by which imported, the amount, date, origin or object of the lien claimed, and giving an address by which notice may be sent of proposed delivery of such goods, which address shall be within one mile of the office of the collector, or other chief officer of customs upon whom the notice is served.
