MOBILE, Oct. 4, 1866. The cool and bracing weather that has recently paid us a number of visits, prolonging his stay each time progressively, is bringing back the idlers who have whiled away the sultry summer days among the pleasant retreats of the Eastern shore and at far away watering places. These enable the Southern communities to bear up cheerfully and hopefully under all the discouraging circumstances of their situation, but the spirit of gaiety evinced through balls, concerts, theaters, etc., seems something akin to the reckless idleness in which many a poor devil in a great city, without home, friends, money or credit, forgets his woes for a brief period. It is a trait of human nature, however, to be merry over the misfortunes that befall ourselves or others, to look a brief and sometimes, eternal oblivion of them. To appear in the Parisian populace during the bloodiest days of the reign of terror, when the seventy theaters of the great French metropolis were crowded every night.

Notwithstanding the condition of poverty to which Southern cities are reduced, their public amusements and their newspapers will be the last yet given up, should fate ordain for them a yet longer deep and unproductive winter. The papers, however, will survive the winter of human nature, seldom take in soil for either financial or political storms, and for aught it can see the newspapers thrive and flourish almost as they did when the country sent up its tide of four million cotton bales and we had a specie currency and no internal revenue collector. Here the theater of Messrs. Boig & McDonough has opened with what is said to be a very good stock company, and those gentlemen have made engagements with an equal number of "stars" to appear during the season. Another theater is to open a few days, in Old Fellows' Hall. The prospect seems to be that both will drive a lucrative business—and this in a city with a white population of not more than forty thousand, and at a time when one meets idle men everywhere on the streets, who declare that they can get nothing to do.

Justify the newspaper business, I think being rather overdone here. We have our large daily papers—the Times, Advertiser, Tribune and Gazette—three of which publish weekly and evening editions. These journals present a mural array of editorial talent. To persons acquainted with newspaper men in the South, such names as John Forsyth, Majors Waldall and Hatcher, Henry St. Paul, Nixon, Ballentyne, Capt. Johnson who commanded the late Tennessee in the battle of Mobile Bay, Heggston, and last but not least, a major of the same name, are names of honor and journalistic abilities and high scholarly attainments. The minor departments are also well conducted, much better in fact than many well pretentious metropolitan sheets. It is to me, however, an unexplainable mystery how four such expensive establishments manage to thrive in a city of the dimensions of Mobile, whose progress and prosperity are severely hampered by monopolies and unwise municipal legislation, that her people are continually the most monstrous impositions and exactions.

The Times of this city laid before the public, a few days ago, a chapter of these impositions and exactions amounting to enormous charges made upon articles of prime necessity shipped hither from New Orleans. The public have no election but to submit to the most outrageous extortion on every hand, as the market is an unyielding, remorseless monopoly, and the butchers and other retailers combine to keep everything at famine prices. If a merchant or manufacturer comes to the aid of the Times would have convinced them of the folly of prohibiting the retailing of any articles of prime necessity except by certain privileged parties, who, if they do pay into the city treasury a little extra revenue, enrich themselves an hundred fold in proportion from the pockets of the people, whose whole substance is swallowed up by taxation and extortionate prices of food and rent. I think that the people of this city are entitled to an extent in other Southern cities, but doubtless this had enough in all.
