The letter of our Washington correspondent, published in our paper gives some interesting details with reference to the federal offices in New Orleans and Louisiana.

THE PARIS EXHIBITION.—We published to-day our inside paper a circular issued by the United States agent for the Paris Exposition, announcing an abridgement of the space allotted to the display of agricultural implements, and a consequent reduction of the number of such articles to be exhibited.

DEPARTMENT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INTERNAL REVENUE.—We have been favored with a letter from a gentleman in New York to Messrs. G. & G. Gardner & Co., of this city, from which we make the following extracts: "A morning paper says: 'The commissioner of internal revenue has decided to instruct collectors not to make seizures of canned meats, vegetables, fruits, etc., which are offered for sale without stamps, when it is shown that such articles were prepared and sold before the 1st of October.'"

THE REPORTS OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INTERNAL REVENUE.—We notice in the Richmond (Va.) papers an announcement of the death of Henry W. Monroe, Esq., of the firm of Dunlop, Monroe & Co., of that city. Mr. Monroe was well known in New Orleans, which he was in the habit of visiting every winter for many years before the war.

EDITOR BULLETIN.—This morning Mr. James Polk, one of those heroes with a quarter square of ground, came to my aid, and said that he had called on and asked for his rent of two military officers, who occupy the large house and other quarters in grand style, and that they said they could not pay, and would not him in the guard house. They owned rent from May last. The house is very large, and worth seventy-five dollars a month. In a few minutes he was arrested and put in the guard-house. In about five minutes he was brought out, taken back to his quarters, and in five minutes he was split up for the use of these officers. He said the man is a forced laborer.

LETTER OF MR. BROWNING.

Mr. Browning, the secretary of the interior, has recently addressed a letter to a committee of citizens of Quincy, Illinois, on the subject of the constitutional amendment. If this letter were the mere expression of individual opinion, it would be of no importance; but, owing to peculiar circumstances, it is suggestive in more than one way. Mr. Browning has always been a republican in politics. He was called to the President's cabinet as a representative of that party, as it was constituted when Mr. Johnson was elected to the vice-presidency. He does not profess to have changed his opinions. As to the issues of that day he holds the views now which he held then. As to the general principles which guide his political conduct, his sentiments of to-day are identical with the sentiments of last year. From the manner in which he views the amendment, we may therefore understand something of the manner in which it is viewed, not by the radicals, who are pressing it on the country with so much of passionate eagerness, but by men who, whilst they recognize fully, thoughtfully and dispassionately, have never heretofore sided with the South. If such men consider the amendment an odious exercise of power; an attempt to oppress unjust conditions as the price of inalienable rights; a scheme to convert the government into a consolidated despotism; surely those to the South, who have distrusted their own judgment in this matter, and who may have felt tempted to yield their convictions for the sake of an imaginary benefit, ought to be ashamed that they ever permitted themselves to doubt the justice of the attitude now occupied by the Southern people.

Mr. Browning's letter is likewise important to the extent that it may be considered a semi-official denial of the reports that the President has been swayed from his position by the result of the Northern elections. We have never entertained a doubt on this point; but papers like the New York Herald and the New York Times have attempted to terrify the South into acquiescence, by declaring that the President was about to change his position and recommend the ratification of the amendment. This expedient had no apparent effect on public opinion; but, if pressed with zeal, it might have weakened opposition among those who feel a natural gratitude to the President for the firm stand which he has taken in the defense of the rights of the States and of the great principles of public liberty. Happily, there is now no longer any such danger. The letter of the secretary of the interior, no doubt, emboldens the President's views; and it shows that the executive opposition to the amendment is founded on fixed convictions and principles.

Mr. Browning commences by arguing that if governmental aggression is to be feared in this country, (and who doubts it, after the events of the last five years?) such aggression is far more apt to assume a permanently dangerous form in the hands of the legislative than in those of the executive department. Such was the opinion of nearly all of our eminent statesmen in times past; and the history of the present Congress furnishes a remarkable confirmation of its truth.

Mr. Browning demonstrates the aggressive character of the proposed amendment in the antagonism it will inevitably provoke between the federal and State tribunals. Slight as this might be at the outset, it is in the nature of power to fortify itself, and having once drawn into the vortex of federal jurisdiction those innumerable questions which now are assigned to the State courts, there would soon be no use for State tribunals at all, and the whole judicial system of the country would be undermined.

He argues conclusively against the insidious change of the basis of representation contemplated by the amendment, and shows that non-voters are not uncounted for, since they are counted in fixing the relative weight of the communities to which they belong in the legislative assembly. He meets the current objection of increasing the relative strength of the South by reminding us that no change can be made in the representation till after the census of 1870, when, in all probability, the entire black population will be less than the three-fifths of 1850. He urges the injustice of counting the non-voting population in the North, while rejecting it in the South.

In regard to the third section, he well says that no such proscription has been proposed since the day of Philip II. of Spain. Nor is it to be expected that a high-spirited race will impose it voluntarily on their fellow-countrymen.

He disposes thoroughly of the charge of executive usurpation. The President, finding the people of the Southern States without organizations, was bound by his oath of office to restore them by the shortest possible method to civil rule. It was his duty to prevent anarchy, and see that "the machinery of the legitimate governments was again put in operation"; to see that the federal laws were executed, and the relations of the federal and State governments restored. In this he but followed in the footsteps of Mr. Lincoln, and is denounced therefore by the same men who assailed his predecessor.

Mr. Browning aptly exposes the hollowness of those now arraigning the President by proving that had Mr. Johnson adopted the universal suffrage and amnesty proposition of Senator Stewart, no oaths, no indictments would have been insisted on, and the horror of admitting "traitors" to Congress and attending with them would have been forgotten. Yet in his policy the President is outstripped by the only two original "traitors" of Mr. Lincoln—Messrs. Seward and Welles. The offense of the President, however, is in insisting that it is the duty of Congress to obey the plain provisions of the Constitution, and judge of the elections, returns, and qualifications of applicants for seats.

Last week at Chicago, a man and his wife died of cholera without any attendant except a child seven years of age. Several hours after their decease they were discovered by the police. Sitting on the floor in one corner was the little boy who had passed the night in solitude and sorrow, frightened by the solemnity of the scene, but unconscious of his great loss.

GENERALISHERIDAN AND ORTEGA.

General Ortega seems as little disposed to be thought a "factionist" as Maximilian probably would desire to be regarded an "imperial buccaner." He does not seem to appreciate the high courtesies of official intercourse as practiced by some of the dignitaries of the model republic. The letter of instructions sent by General Sheridan to the commander at Brownsville has elicited a communication from General Ortega to General Sheridan, which, though many times the length of General Sheridan's letter, does not apply an offensive epithet to any one of the so-called authorities in Mexico or the bona fide authorities in the United States. He denies, however, that he represents a "faction," and repels indignantly the insinuation of any purpose on his part to violate the neutrality of this country. He asserts that he is "the true and only representative of the constitutional law of Mexico, to which nation," he adds, "belongs the right to decide its internal affairs," and he clinches the proposition thus advanced by actually signing himself "Constitutional President of the Republic of Mexico."

After repelling the attack which was so suddenly and unexpectedly made in an indirect manner upon him and his partisans, Senator Ortega, assuming the offensive, carries the war boldly into Africa, and charges Gen. Sheridan with having himself violated the neutrality laws from the moment he pronounces "the heartiest support to the adherents of Senor Juarez," and denounces as a faction the upholders of the legitimate government of Mexico. This, sir, he adds, "although indirectly, is an attempt to impose on that nation a government against its will and against its constitutional laws; it is also an attempt to intervene in the internal questions of the Republic of Mexico, which she alone has the right to decide."

Senator Ortega states that "at first" he "could not understand" General Sheridan's communication, but mature reflection convinced him at last that it did not concern me. Yesterday, however, two officers of your staff handed me a copy of the above mentioned document, without any communication for me, and with only my name written on the envelope, as an indication that it was addressed to me. I once more read its contents, and could not be persuaded that it concerned me at all, nor what you meant by transmitting it to me in such a manner.

We would gladly come to the relief of Senator Ortega in aiding him to interpret this novel action of General Sheridan, if it were in our power to do so. We would suggest for his relief, however, that it would be well for him to learn, before returning to his native country, that the "pleasantry" practiced by many military and other authorities in the model republic, though sometimes "harmless" often appear in novel and unexpected forms; and that it is proper that distinguished foreigners who may be the subjects of them should be moved at once to administration. It may not be in accordance with his ideas of courtesy to be the recipient of a copy of an official communication addressed by one official of our government to another without some letter to himself in explanation of what is "meant by transmitting it in such a manner." But Senator Ortega should remember that he is only a benighted savage, and that he should come to this country to learn, and not with any expectation of imposing his antiquated notions of official courtesy upon those who have made such progressive strides in this age of progress. Besides, he should remember that the appearance of "two staff officers" as bearers of the communication in question, answered every purpose of a letter, and should be considered as forcible logic as the sword of Brennus, when thrown into the scale of controversy.

As Gen. Sheridan's letter seems to have complicated our relations somewhat with one of the "constitutional presidents" of the republic of Mexico, we think he owes it to himself and the government to repeat in another communication the charge brought by Senor Ortega of his having violated the strictly neutral policy of the government. In this expected official communication, we may confidently congratulate Senor Ortega, in advance, of his being the recipient of a lesson in the proper use of adjectives as applied to obnoxious adversaries; a careful study of which may redound greatly to his benefit in the future political complications of his own country.

THE ACADEMY.—The best thing at present going on at the Academy is the lecture by Bob Hat upon the impending crisis in which all the issues which bear upon the politics of the day are discussed with an analysis and logical sequence which ought to secure his nomination for Congress at the next election. A new body of celebrities are on their way to the city and will soon appear with the Hantons.

THE VARIETIES.—Knowles's well known play of the "Hunchback" was given last night before a tolerably filled house, and with a fair degree of success. Signor Carlo Patti also skillfully performed a grand Fantasia, accompanied by his orchestra, and the whole concluded with the popular farce of "Barney, the Baron." Shakespeare's "As You Like It" will be given to-night, with a repetition of Carlo Patti's grand Fantasia.

THE ST. CHARLES.—"Roanoke, or the Knife of Heards," was repeated last night, with almost as large a house as the evening preceding. The final catastrophe of the piece appears a little sad, and leaves careless spectators in some doubt whether there is not more to be seen. But the play undoubtedly takes hold upon the interest of the spectators, and is as powerfully sensational as any that has been brought out this season. The play will be repeated.
