'Tis the disposition of some loving natures to think kindnesses, to plant silent bonnets, to scheme pleasures, to be ever doing some little act of tender affection for those they love.

There are 10,000 beer-shops and public houses in London. Amadeus, second son of Victor Emmanuel, has gone on a cruise in the North Sea.

The will of the Marquis of Salisbury has been sworn under £300,000. The Prince of Wales and the Duke of Cambridge were in the lobby of the House of Lords, working against the Irish church-suspensory bill.

Mr. Batcher, who was page to George III, George IV, William IV, and her present majesty, Queen Victoria, died at Windsor a few weeks since, aged 85. He had been retired on a pension since 1861.

An important change in the Portuguese ministry has just been announced. The Duke de Luze has been appointed minister of interior and foreign affairs, and Conde de Ferrar, minister of justice and public worship.

Prince Albert, nephew of King William, of Prussia, is to marry Princess Mary, daughter of Prince Frederick, of Holland. Albert will be made a general in the North-German army, and put in command of Cassel or Hanover.

The English are still wrangling over the last Derby race. Admiral Ross, who accused John Day, the trainer of Lady Elizabeth, the favorite, of foul play, has been sued by Mr. Day for libel. The damages are laid at £5000.

There are 9000 Jews and six synagogues in Chicago. They pay annually \$50,000 for religious purposes, and have just finished a hospital at an expense of \$30,000, which they raised in ten days. They claim six converts to the Jewish faith from Christianity.

In the case of the United States against M. M. Armond, the builder of the iron-clads for the confederate government, the argument for the prosecution and defense was concluded on the 15th. The court will render its decision within a fortnight.

The persecution of the Israelites in Roumania has ceased in consequence of the energetic protests of the government of Austria. The Vienna papers state that the difference between the two governments on this question has been arranged peaceably. Roumania having yielded to all the demands of Austria.

His Highness the Grand Duke of Mecklenburg-Strelitz honored a jeweler of Bond street, London, with a call and purchased a watch of high price which he forgot to pay for. The irate shopkeeper gave chase to his neighbor and caught him, when that illustrious personage suddenly recollected his mistake and forked over the money for the watch.

The London News draws parallel and comparison between the fourth of July festival of independence, and the twelfth of July, day of "wings and arrows," on which Orangemen and Roman Catholics with beautiful unanimity, cut and smash each others' heads in Ireland, to do honor to the memory of William, prince of Orange. This is what a Heistler would term a "yoke."

An explosion of a nitro glycerine manufactory in the neighborhood of Stockholm has been announced. Fourteen persons lost their lives, and the laboratory, with its valuable apparatus, the manager's house, and a small adjoining factory, were totally destroyed. In the city most of the windows were broken, and within a circle of three miles the violent commotion of the air was distinctly felt.

The speakers on the loan in the French chamber seem all to agree on two points—that the empire has spent on an average £12,000,000 a year since 1852 in excess of the revenue, and that the total budget of France cannot be considered less than £120,000,000 already, and in fifty years two-thirds of her income would be mortgaged to the debt.

A clerk in the employ of the East India Company recently penned the following lines to his official superior, a Honored Sir, I humbly beg you will excuse my not attending office this date, cause I got a boil as per margin." In the margin of the letter a sketch of the boil was drawn out, and the writer went on further to say, "The breadth of paper being short, I have planned the boil small, but it is double the size."

Miss Kellogg has met with remarkable success in London. In the "Daughter of the Regiment," the Standard says her singing was "beyond all praise." "She was recalled after every act, and was received each time with genuine enthusiasm. At the fall of the curtain, when she was summoned before the footlights, the stage was literally rained over with bouquets, and the scene rendered more forcibly of a night during the Jenny Lind furore, when operatic excitement was at the fever height."

Louisa Muhlbaeh is engaged in writing a historical novel entitled "From Solferino to Koniggratz." It is a very voluminous. Her late novel, "Schiller and Goethe, and the sequel, Prince Louis Ferdinand, have been unsuccessful in Germany. Janke, her Berlin publisher, has made a large fortune out of the Muhlbaeh books, which he sells, in paper covers, at about three times the rate charged for the well bound and handsomely illustrated translations published in the United States.

On the 16th of June Pius IX commenced the twenty-third year of his pontifical reign. Since St. Peter, to whom history assigns twenty-five years, has been but three popes out of 258 who have lived to commence or to finish their twenty-third year of government. They are: Adrian I, the pope of Charlemagne; Pius VI, the pope of the directory; and Pius VII, the pope of Napoleon I. Pius IX will be the fourth. If he lives as long as Pius VII, he will be matched only by St. Peter. But if he survives June 16, 1871, he will have outdone not only all preceding popes, but St. Peter himself.

The Parisian courts have recently sent several bold wet-nurses to the penitentiary. Infant mortality is said to be increased in an alarming degree by young girls accepting situations as wet-nurses, when they are not "wet" at all. As a wet-nurse receives much larger wages than dry nurses, a great number of girls seek such situations in the former capacity, and thereby bring about the death of the poor little worms intrusted to them.

A pontifical bull summoning a general council of the Catholic church to meet in the Basilica of the Vatican on the 8th of December, 1863, has been formally promulgated. All ecclesiastics entitled to be present are enjoined to appear, or, if prevented, to be represented by proxy. The pope expresses hopes that princes and other rulers will afford their co-operation, and that the council will be a happy and successful one.

Schneider, on her first appearance in the "Grand Duchess" at an English theater, toned down all the extravaganzas for which she had made herself so famous as Chatelet and Varieties, owing to the presence of at least a score of distinguished and princely personages connected by blood with the royal family of England. The cancan was suppressed, and Schneider refused positively to host her leg above the footlights. This modest department met with great disfavor from the distinguished people in the boxes, and a loud cry of discontent arose from them. The second representation satisfied their wishes. Schneider exhibited her pedals in a manner worthy of her reputation.

An English journal says: "It seems to be thought by Americans who have seen the latest editions of 'Martin Chuzzlewit' and the 'American Notes,' that Mr. Dickens has scarcely fulfilled the spirit of his promise, in that his dinner in New York, where he drew his celebrated picture of two worlds overran by icebergs and Arctic bears.
