EXECUTIVE NOMINATIONS.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 8.—The Supreme Court has affirmed the decision of the Supreme Court of Oregon, requiring taxes to be paid in gold and silver. The court holds that taxes are not in the nature of a debt or contract, and therefore the legal tender law does not affect them.

The Senate railroad committee asked to be discharged from further consideration of the various propositions for aid, the omnibus bill reported on Saturday, covering all meritorious schemes now presented.

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Local Intelligence.

THE FOLLOWING ORDERS were issued yesterday by the superintendent of police, with reference to the preservation of the peace during the festivities of to-day:

SUPERINTENDENT'S OFFICE, METROPOLITAN POLICE, New Orleans, Feb. 8, 1869.

Special Order No. 34

I. For the purpose of preserving the peace within the city of New Orleans to-morrow (Mardi Gras), it is hereby ordered that all persons violating article 681, city ordinance relating to offenses and nuisances, which makes it unlawful to throw flour or any other substance on any person passing along the street, and all persons appearing in disguise on the streets, except those of the Comus, shall be arrested and confined in the lockup of the precinct in which they may be arrested.
