COMMON COUNCIL.

BOARD OF ASSISTANT ALDERMEN.

REGULAR SESSION.

CITY HALL, NEW ORLEANS, February 23, 1899.

The board met in regular session pursuant to adjournment.

Present—President Kearny in the chair, and Messrs. Rose, Aitkens, Pemberton, Camp, Strucken, Fisher, Morphy, Pandey, Farrell and Breen.

The reading of the minutes of the last meeting was on motion dispensed with.

The following communication from the street commissioner, accompanied by a communication from the mayor's secretary, was read:

STREET COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, Room No. 7, City Hall, New Orleans, February 23, 1899.

To the Honorable the Board of Assistant Aldermen, City of New Orleans:

Gentlemen: Numerous complaints are frequently made by the citizens of the city, causing frequent delay in the transportation of merchandise, and in some instances serious loss to owners of drays and other vehicles, who are not in a good condition to transport them. They argue that as they are called upon to pay promptly heavy city and other taxes, they have a right to some immediate relief in their hands, which I concede to be correct. I am quite powerless to give them, in consequence of not having had for some time any material wherewith to make the necessary repairs. I therefore deem it my duty to ask your honorable body to take this subject under your consideration and devise some plan by which I shall be enabled to procure ballast, etc., for immediate use, and stay the causes of complaint.

I also take this occasion to respectfully ask your advice with regard to my annual ordinance No. 1141, N. S., relative to public stables, etc., as in attempting to put it in force recently I have been restrained by a letter from his honor the mayor, a copy of which is herewith inclosed for your perusal.

CONTROLLER'S OFFICE, City Hall, New Orleans, Feb. 23, 1899.

To the Honorable the Common Council:

Gentlemen—I have the honor to report to your honorable body, that on the 19th inst., in accordance with an advertisement in the official journal, calling for sealed proposals for the furnishing of a powder magazine on property belonging to the city, for the term of five years, I have received the following bids:

Edward F. Shields—security, G. Correlles—five hundred (\$500) dollars per annum.

And on the 20th inst., in accordance with ordinance No. 1258, N. S., I adjudge the contract for collecting and receiving all licenses on all itinerant merchants, peddlers, agents, etc., to F. B. Hernandez—security, Geo. W. Walden—at \$4,750 four thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars for the term of one year.

Resolved, That the surveyor be and he is hereby authorized to have repaired the house of Pelican Hook and Ladder Fire Company No. 4; provided, the cost does not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500).

The finance committee submitted the following report:

To the Honorable the President and Members of the Board of Assistant Aldermen:

Gentlemen—Your committee beg leave to report as follows on the different matters referred to them:

On the petition of F. Zoller, barber, praying to be relieved from payment of a license, unfavorably.

On the petition of Boyd, Coleman & Graham, praying to be refunded one-half the license paid by them last year, unfavorably.

On the claim of Chas. Mallot, referred back to this committee, praying to be remunerated for a lot of ground taken by the city for the opening of new St. Bernard street, your committee, after an examination of the titles, and in accordance with the opinion of the city attorney and city surveyor, report back the original ordinance, amended so as to read \$300 instead of \$450.

Your committee beg leave to state that after a long and tedious examination of the accounts and returns of the collectors of levee dues of the different districts, they have found the accounts of these officers correct.
