HOW CAN SPAIN FIGHT

With the United States When She Can't Whip Cuba,

He Says—"The Spanish Are a Bad Lot."

"Within a week President McKinley has absolutely dropped in his attitude towards Spain and his announcement of an aggressive policy at this time is much more in accord with the sentiments of the American people than the waiting and watching which has been going on since the Maine disaster."

THE POLICY OF THE NATIONAL ADMINISTRATION AT THIS TIME IS ONE OF PREPARATION FOR WAR.

The president is evidently feeling that a better bargain can be made with Spain with reference to the Cuban matter with a complete navy and a large army behind him. It is true that a man can always make a better deal when he has a revolver in his hand for the purpose of enforcing the terms which are proposed.

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The president has absolutely reliable information that the Maine disaster was the result of a conspiracy on the part of the Spanish. This has not been confirmed, but I think it is generally believed.

A BILL FOR ITS CONSTRUCTION

Washington, March 9.—The Pacific cable bill has been agreed to in the house committee on interstate and foreign commerce. It provides for the construction of a cable from San Francisco to Japan via the Hawaiian islands and grants an amount of \$50,000 for twenty years.
