Atchison, Kan., Dec. 4.—Bishop Leonard, of the Episcopal church, who died at Salt Lake City Thursday, of typhoid fever, was rector of Trinity church, Atchison, for six years. He came here from Hannibal, Mo., in 1881, and served until chosen missionary bishop of Utah and Nevada in the fall of 1887. He was greatly beloved. Bishop Leonard was born in Fayette, Mo., and was 55 years old.
