STOOD IT FOUR HOURS

New York, Oct. 23.—A distinctly more favorable tone was evident in Wall street at 2 o'clock this afternoon following the announcement that Secretary Cortelyou of the treasury department had made deposits of government funds in New York banks.

The heavy run of depositors on the Trust Company of America brought to a close the panic developments in the Morse-Helzlsouer banks last week until the closing of the Knickerbocker Trust company yesterday.

The stock market opened excited and lower but rallied from the opening point and the leading stocks held much firmer than expected.

STOCK EXCHANGE CLOSES. Pittsburgh Is Hit by the Financial Condition in Wall Street.
