AT PRISON GATES.

Postoffice Robber Gets Release and Arrested While Leaving Pen. Leavenworth, Kan., July 25.—Billy Black who, according to the federal officers, is one of the most notorious postoffice robbers in this country, was arrested as he left the United States penitentiary here last night, after serving a term of two years for robbing the postoffice at Wellsville, Mo. The warrant upon which he was arrested charged him with robbing the postoffice at Bucklin, Mo., in 1908, a few months before the Wellsville robbery was committed.

TAKE GOVERNMENT LAND.

Ten Quarter Sections Filed on at Dodge City Office. Great Bend, Kan., July 25.—According to a report received by County Clerk Youkin from the government land office at Dodge City, Kansas, ten quarters of land have been added to the tax rolls of Barton county during the past twelve months. They are all located in Cheyenne township in what is known to sportsmen throughout western Kansas as the Cheyenne Bottoms. Barton is generally considered a county without government lands.
