LONDON IN REPRISALS

Berlin Complaints of Anti-German Outbreaks Due to Teutonic Success.

Berlin, Sept. 17.—(Wireless to Tuckerton.)—The recent great successes by the Germans on the eastern and western fronts and the last Zeppelin raid on London have caused an outbreak of anti-German feeling in that city, says the Overseas News agency.

"There have been numerous arrests, mostly of Germans who have been naturalized in England, young men and women who previously had been arrested and released, and there has been a revival of the panic over espionage."

The singing of Madison and Nace was not received as it should be, as the 40-second duo could really warble. Allen and White, whistlers, presented ragtime and classic tunes, in addition to whistling imitations. Their act was O. K. The Three Lyons, Harvey, Henderson and Leonard, put over a musical act. The trio xylophone playing was far superior to El Cota, the artist here early in the week. On month instruments the three did well. Their jokes, with a few exceptions, were antediluvian.
