

PILED ON GROUND

Elevators in Kansas Overflow With Wheat Crop. Railroad Unable to Supply Cars for Shipment. THRESHING NOT YET FINISHED. Prices High in Spite of Large 1916 Crop. Growers Forced to Hold Grain by Car Shortage.

Hutchinson, Kan., July 31.—Thousands of bushels of wheat in the Kansas grain district are being piled on the ground and in temporary bins awaiting shipment. The elevators are all filled and the railroads are unable to provide cars to haul away the crop. From all over the district are coming stories of bumper wheat crops and the impossibility of obtaining cars for shipment.

Lewis, Kan., reports that all but one of the elevators at that place are full and more wheat is coming in all the time. Threshing machines are still working at that place and the farmers are being forced to use all available bins and sheds and even to store the grain on the ground.

The wheat yield in Ford county, according to word from Dodge City, is larger than was expected by most of the farmers. The market price stays high in spite of the large crop and a large amount of the grain is being sold.

Piled Along Two Railroads. Pratt, Kan., July 31.—Twelve thousand bushels of wheat is now lying on the ground near the Farmers' Equity office near the Rock Island tracks. No cars are available to move the grain. It is estimated that 500 cars will be necessary to fill the demand. The Anthony Northern road,

which has just completed a line of track here, has placed an order for 200 cars but there seems little chance to get them very soon. Large piles of wheat are lying all along the route of the Rock Island and the Anthony Northern.

Many farmers who have adequate storing facilities would sell their grain at the present price if cars were available. The local Equity union estimated that the crop would be harvested by the middle of this week. The past dry weather has been ideal for threshing and the machines have lost no time since starting.

The wheat in this county will average about ten bushels to the acre but with high test and far better price the farmers will realize nearly as much as last year on the crop. Several machines already have finished their runs and pulled in Saturday.

Wheat Buying Stopped. Montezuma, Kan., July 31.—The three elevators here are full of wheat now and two of them have about ten thousand bushels piled on the ground. All companies have quit buying and the farmers are forced to quit threshing or pile the grain on the ground as many have not the room for storing.

When threshing first started here there were many empty cars in the railroad yards but they have all been taken to other points and it is impossible to procure shipping facilities here.
