Harry Hashburger, who was brought back from Nebraska, by L. L. Kiene, sheriff, on a warrant charging wife desertion, filed suit in the district court today for a divorce from his wife, who swore to the original complaint.

By filing a divorce petition Hashburger put it up to the court to determine whether or not he was justified in deserting his wife.

The Hashburgers were married April 4, 1907. There are no children. He states in his petition that he tried to live with his wife and do everything in his power to make her comfortable and happy.

He charges that because of her extravagance he is now in debt. In March of this year, Hashburger says in his petition, he rented a house and an acre of ground in North Topeka and that Mrs. Hashburger refused to leave her mother to live with him; that she visited him occasionally but declined to live with him as his wife.

When she did visit, he says, she called him vile names and told him she cared more for others than she did for him.

Hashburger is out on bond on the felony charge. Mrs. Hashburger was taken to the county before the sheriff went after her husband, covering all expenses.


