Democrats Brand O'Leary Conference Blow at Loyalty. Republicans Claim Labor Leaders Disavow 8-Hour Law.

SHORT AND UGLY ALIBI ON BOOZE

McLaughlin Denounces Gray's Last Affidavit as False. Says His Honor as Attorney Has Been Impeached.

John McLaughlin, the Osage City attorney, who prosecuted Hugh Larimer, undersheriff, on the charge of murder following the killing of James Baker, stated in Topeka today that O. C. Gray "lied" in his affidavit that the shooting was offered during the trial of the case in connection with a contingent fee. The affidavit was in effect that he, Gray, saw Larimer shoot Baker and that the shooting was not an accident. But it is not because of this affidavit that the attorney charges him with falsifying.

Gray disappeared after the affidavit was made and at the time of the trial he could not be found. Because of his absence Mr. McLaughlin attempted to secure a continuance. Friends of Hugh Larimer who did not believe Gray was the shooting and who did not believe he would testify under oath as he did in the affidavit, also made efforts to find him.
