Huge British Plane Will Attempt Nonstop Flight... Flyers Intend To Follow Hawker's Course Across... CAPTAIN ALCOCK AT WHEEL

Lieut. A. W. Brown, American, Is His Navigator... Machine Has High Speed and Full Wireless Equipment... St. Johns, June 14.—Off on an attempted non-stop flight over the Atlantic from Newfoundland to Ireland...

The machine, with Capt. John Alcock at the wheel, swept north from the ground, and rose gradually to an altitude of 1,000 feet... A crowd of spectators gathered around the plane...

Only 67 Feet Wide... The machine has a wing spread of only sixty-seven feet, and is equipped with two 250 horsepower Rolls-Royce motors... Cap. Jack Alcock, the pilot, was among the British pioneers in aviation...
