Only a few Jayhawkers' regulars were used against the Kansas Aggies and these only for a short time in order that all of the Kansas strength could be used on November 6. A number of rosters are going from Lawrence.

They Are Prepared.

Columbia, Mo., Nov. 3.—Preparations are being made in Columbia, these days for the handling of the out of town attendance at the annual Missouri-Kansas football game to be played here Thanksgiving day. Applications for reserved seat tickets will be received until November 12. The application should be addressed to Z. G. Cleveland, athletic director, Rothwell gymnasium. An enclosure of a self-addressed envelope and 12 cents should be included in the order, together with the price of the number of seats desired.

A limit of six bleacher seats or one box of eight seats for any one person or organization has been set, and no exceptions are to be made to this rule. The allotment of tickets to applicants will be made by drawing on November 15. For a reserved bleacher seat the price is \$3, and on a reserved box seat \$25.

In anticipation of an unusually large number of out of town persons in attendance at the game, the athletic department is working together with the citizens of Columbia on plans to accommodate visitors. The hotels are being held out for weeks, but it is hoped rooms may be procured in private residences in Columbia. To this end the civic organizations are co-operating in compiling a list of those persons who are able to accommodate visitors over the week-end.

St. Mary's vs. Baker.

"The biggest game on the schedule" is the way St. Mary's supporters are looking forward to Friday's contest—when Baker and St. Mary's teams play the St. Mary's eleven at St. Mary's. This is the first time in the history of athletic relations between these two colleges that the football representatives have met on the gridiron. Both teams this year play the same style of football, running at the line, and in fact, the Baker team in shape—it will be a wonderful match between him and the speedy Green on the Baker team. 
