

NEWS OF THE WEEK.

The News from All Parts of the World.

ABROAD. The Town Hall at Warrminster, England, was partially wrecked by an explosion of dynamite on the night of the 14th. Several houses in the neighborhood were badly shaken, many windows shattered and several persons thrown to the ground by the concussion. The earthquake troubles were felt during last week at Torrox, Canillas, Almuñecar and Algebro, Spain. The storm in the southern provinces still continues, and has been greatly swollen. The sufferings of the people who have been rendered homeless by the earthquakes are intense. According to the official record the number of persons killed by the earthquakes in Granada was 693, and the number injured 1,489. By the explosion of fire-dump in a mine at Pas-le-Clais, France, on the 15th inst., 28 men were killed. The condition of affairs in Russia is most alarming. Civil war is raging in Caudinamara, Bogaya, Santander and Magdalena, and it seems as if about to break out in the important State of Cauca. Heavy fighting has already taken place in the interior. The Radical party, as it is called, has joined a faction of the Conservatives. Thus united they are endeavoring to turn out the Liberal Government in the different States, which are the strongest supporters of the Government of President Nunez, and then, if successful, they will unite the States they hold in an effort to overthrow the General Government. The condition of the working classes in England is deplorable. Meetings of the starving people are being held at different points in the country, and petitions are presented in London. One of the latter was approved if the condition of affairs does not soon improve. An anti-Jewish riot occurred at Vilkomir, Russia, on the 14th. A party of army recruits made forcible entry upon the Jewish residents. One of the latter was killed. The police were powerless to quell the disturbance, but the firemen came to the rescue and dispersed the rioters.

CRIMES AND CASUALTIES. The clothing of a four-year-old child of Amos Price, of Rushville, Ind., caught fire recently from a stove, and she was burned to death. George Barbee, engineer, was killed and Wm. Hough, fireman, and A. Lowry, brakeman, severely injured by a freight train jumping the track at Summit, O., on the 15th inst. A fire at Fayetteville, N. C., on the 16th inst. destroyed the stores of F. W. Thurston, Warren Pryor, and other property; loss \$121,700. Insurance over \$45,000. The north side of the public square at Jonesboro, Ark., including seven business houses, was burned on the 14th; loss \$70,000. The steam saw-mill belonging to J. B. Williams, near Smithfield, O., exploded on the 13th inst. The boiler was blown a mile away. Three persons were killed and one badly hurt. Geo. Travis was hanged in the jail at Wellsboro, Pa., on the 15th inst. for the murder of Martha Sylvia in Charleston, Tioga County, Pa., on April 3, 1883. He afterward burned the remains in a vault belonging to J. B. Williams, near Smithfield, O., exploded on the morning of the 18th, and 17 patients lost their lives.

POLITICAL. The Democratic caucus of the Connecticut Legislature nominated Wm. H. Barnum for United States Senator on the 14th inst. The Republican caucus nominated Hon. Orville H. Platt. The Republican majority in the Legislature on joint ballot is 82, making Mr. Platt's re-election certain. Senator Don Cameron was nominated for re-election to the U. S. Senate by the Republican caucus at Harrisburg, Pa., on the 15th inst. Senator John J. Ingalls, of Kansas, was nominated for re-election to the U. S. Senate on the 16th inst. The Democratic caucus at Raleigh, N. C., nominated for re-election Senator Z. B. Vance for re-election.

INDUSTRIAL. A general cut down in wages has been agreed upon by mills in Lawrence, Lowell and Manchester, Mass., and will take effect this month. Nearly all the mills in Lowell, including the Pacific, are in the agreement. The Logan and Centralia (Pa.) collieries, operated by L. A. Biley & Co., suspended work on the 15th for an indefinite period, throwing 90 men and boys out of employment. The Central Falls Woolen Mills, at Providence, R. I., shut down on the 15th, for an indefinite time, throwing 135 hands out of work. On the 15th the Ohio Harrow Works, of Painesville, Pa., suspended with liabilities between \$3,000,000 and \$5,000,000. The business failures during the seven days ending Jan. 17 numbered 10 in the United States, 382, and for Canada 35, or a total of 420, as compared with a total of 457 last week.

MISCELLANEOUS. Hon. Erastus S. Ransom, formerly the law partner of President Andrew Johnson, died on the 14th at Miss Carol P. Edwards, of Brooklyn. The fourth cremation took place at the Lancaster (Pa.) Crematory on the 15th inst., when the body of Maj. Charles B. Brady, of St. Louis, who committed suicide at his home in that city last Friday night, was incinerated. One of the largest whales ever captured in the Long Island coast was hauled last week by the fish-boat of Capt. Bridgehampton, L. I. The whale will yield from 75 to 100 barrels of oil. The loss of sheep and cattle in Northern Texas on account of the extreme cold has been immense, many thousands dying in some instances on a single ranch. Three hundred out of the 700 workmen employed in Aultman, Miller & Co's Moving and Repair Works at Akron, O., are prostrated by a strange malady. The symptoms are violent purging and gripping pains in the stomach and bowels, while the victim suffers excruciating agony. No deaths have yet been reported. In the Pennsylvania Senate on the 16th Mr. Adams introduced a bill for the infliction of corporal punishment upon all men convicted of fully beating their wives or beating any other female persons.

La Electrical Storm. During the passage of the American Line steamship British King, which arrived at Philadelphia on the 14th inst. from Swansea, she encountered a blinding electrical storm, such a storm has never before been experienced by a trans-Atlantic vessel. The ship was off St. George's bank on the previous Monday during a heavy rain and thunder-storm. The electricity in the clouds had become so intense that it blinded the men on the lookout, and as a precaution against accident the engines were stopped. The horizon as far as the eye could reach was flashing with lightning, and of a sudden sheets of lightning. At the same time St. Elmo's fire appeared on the yardarms and mastsheads in the shape of luminous meteors.

A Dying Man Tells How He Killed a Peddler for His Money. Robert Merchant, who has for some years resided at Green Lanes Co., N. Y., died on Sunday night of last week; but before he expired confessed to the commission of a horrible crime in 1868, when he lived at a tavern in the neighborhood. In that year a man who was peddling through the County put up at his house, and Merchant finding out that he had considerable money with him, stole up to his chamber in the night and brained the unlucky man while sleeping. After securing all his valuables he carried the body down stairs and buried it in a corner of the cellar. The day after Merchant's death two men went to the house designated, and after digging about three feet into the cellar floor discovered the remains of a human being.

The Crops. The annual report of the Department of Agriculture makes the record of corn production for the year 1884 1,795,000,000 bushels, that of wheat nearly 313,000,000, and of oats 583,000,000.
