

NEWS OF THE WEEK

The Mayor of Waterford, Ireland, presided at a crowded meeting of citizens last week held for the purpose of taking steps to compel the removal of Waterford to remove royal portraits from the Council Chamber and hang in their stead a portrait of Gen. Thomas Francis Meagher, who was convicted of sedition in the rebellion of 1848.

Leni Rodecker, a young German woman, was sent to the insane asylum at Trenton, N. J., last Wednesday. Three weeks ago she drank milk from a cow that had been bitten by a dog which was said to be mad.

Marinelli's Remains Removed to Italy. The remains of the Italian patriot and poet, Pietro Marinelli, died in 1839, were placed in a casket of white wood of the size that would have been necessary for a child's corpse and sent to Italy.

GEN. GRANT'S TOMB
