

AFTERMATH OF THE ENCAMPMENT.


Reunions Held During the Week—Callers at National Tribune Headquarters—Snapshots at the Great Parade.

The veterans of the 5th N. Y. H. A. assembled in Reunion at Philadelphia during the 33d National Encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic. The meeting was held in Odd Fellows Temple, Wednesday morning. There were present members of each of the 12 companies comprising the regiment, representing New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Ohio, Vermont and Washington, D. C. The President of the Regimental Association, Comrade Chas. Mount, of Philadelphia, called the meeting to order, and requested that Capt. Jos. H. Barker, of New York, take charge of the meeting. Comrade Robt. Cooper, of Yorkville, N. Y., was detailed to act as Secretary. Thirty-five members answered to roll-call. Twelve deaths were reported, making a total of over 300 deaths reported since the establishment of the Association, over 20 years ago. Many letters of regret were received, and also a telegram from President McKinley acknowledging the receipt of an invitation to attend the Reunion. This recognition of President McKinley was received with applause. The Chairman recognized the presence of Capt. G. W. Hoffman, 72d Pa., of Scranton, Pa., one of those representing the Eighth Corps. Comrade Hoffman was called to the platform and responded very thoroughly for the Corps. Addresses were made by Comrade W. W. Hanna, of Philadelphia, and the Hon. W. D. Pudney, of Cleveland, O. Comrade Robert Cooper, of Yorkville, N. Y., gave a full report of his experiences at Piedmont, Va., in 1864, including the wounding

of himself and his two brothers, capture and imprisonment at Andersonville, Ga. His brothers are both dead. One is buried in Staunton, Va., and the other in Annapolis, Md. Comrade Geo. Main, Color-Sergeant of the regiment, residing at Susquehanna, Pa., gave a full account of the preservation of the regimental colors at the battle of Cedar Creek, Va., Oct. 19, 1862. Of the 1,000 members of the regiment engaged in that battle, only about 60 returned to regimental quarters. Other comrades followed with short addresses. During the three hours consumed in Reunion number of comrades met who had not seen each other since the close of the war. Annual Reunions of this order are held in New York City regularly Oct. 19, in commemoration of the anniversary of the battle of Cedar Creek, Va. Capt. Jos. H.
