PENSION POINTERS.

Inquiries Answered and Suggestions Made.

J. B. Patterson, Mo.—Widows of soldiers of the war of the rebellion are entitled to pension only under the general law...

G. W. S., Oakland, W. Va.—Unless it is known quite positively that the report of an Examination Board was unfavorable, it is not safe to conclude merely from the rejection of a claim that the report was unfavorable.

W. M. Harmony, Me.—In the case you mention, the service in the war of the rebellion was less than two years...

J. B. Cave City, Ky.—If disabilities on which pension is claimed did in fact have their origin in the service and line of duty, there is no question as to the fact that it should be granted.

E. S. Langhinstown, Pa.—Pension claimants can of course give evidence themselves in support of their own claims.

DIVISION OF PENSION. Mary A. Hunter appealed from the action of the Pension Bureau...

"Claimant, in her application, filed January 10, 1903, based her claim upon the third proviso of the act of March 3, 1880, that she is the widow of a late soldier of the National Soldiers' Home."

"To entitle claimant to one-half her husband's pension she is required to show that she is in necessitous circumstances."

"Pensioner's condition in life becomes material in determining the necessary condition of the wife, as those words (necessitous circumstances) in the statute naturally refer to the condition of the wife."

"No absolute rule can therefore be laid down which will be applicable alike to all cases, but the question as to whether the wife is or is not in necessitous circumstances should, in the opinion of the Department, be ascertained and determined according to the facts in each particular case."

"In the case under consideration it appears from the evidence that pensioner is 37 years of age, and is unable to perform his support by manual labor, and with no means of support aside from his pension of \$12 per month."
