
CIVIL WAR MUSICIANS. All Requested to Report for Duty at Saratoga, N. Y. To All Members of the National Association of Civil War Musicians:

The Family.

By SENORA SARA. An excessive irritation of the skin that does not amount to prickly heat, but is more annoying, is one of the unpleasant effects of warm weather.

Nettle rash, that looks and feels so like prickly heat, comes from a slight irritation of the skin, and is due to the fact that the blood is impure.

Water is the most universally employed of all cosmetics, and rightly applied it is the best. Notwithstanding that with the great majority the act of face washing averages more than twice a day.

Many complexions are ruined by the employment of sponges and face cloths, and by the use of soap. The soap and impurities of the water remain on the face, and as they are used time after time the decayed soap and collected matter is applied to the face.

It is not generally known that boiling fruit a long time and skimming it well without the sugar and without the preserves, is a most economical and excellent way of economizing because the bulk of the sugar rises from the fruit and not from the sugar in the latter is good, and boiling without a cover and two cups of water, and the water particles therefrom and the preserves keep firm and are well flavored.

Pepper Hash--Twelve green peppers, 12 red or ripe ones; 12 large onions; remove seeds from peppers; wash and chop all together until fine as hash. Pour boiling water over to cover and let stand five minutes. Drain thru colander; press all the water out. Have ready three pints of boiling vinegar, in which you have just four tablespoons of sugar and a small amount of salt. Put hash into this and boil up thoroughly. This is fine for baked beans.

Cover jelly, jam or all preserves with a little good glycerine and mold will be a thing of the past. Always use lard to grease your cake pans. If you use butter causes it to stick to the pan.
