The secret of good coffee is in an immaculate clean coffee pot, fresh boiling water and good material. It is better to pay a little more for your coffee and use less in quantity than would be necessary in the cheaper grades.

All jellies should be kept where it is cool and dark. If you have no dry cellar or dark closet, cover the sides with a cool cloth or black cotton and hang a curtain of the same over the fruit.

It seems almost impossible to keep house without citron preserves and dried citron. The old-fashioned way of putting up citron is to wash it in alum water until tender and green, then in clear water to extract the taste of the alum, and, lastly, in cold water to crisp it before the preserving begins.

Should you prefer the old-fashioned preserves, here are a few recipes for making. Peel and core the citron, cut into strips and cut the edges. Soak overnight in strongly salted water. In the morning soak in clear cold water, changing until freshened. Parboil 10 minutes in water with a teaspoonful of powdered alum.
